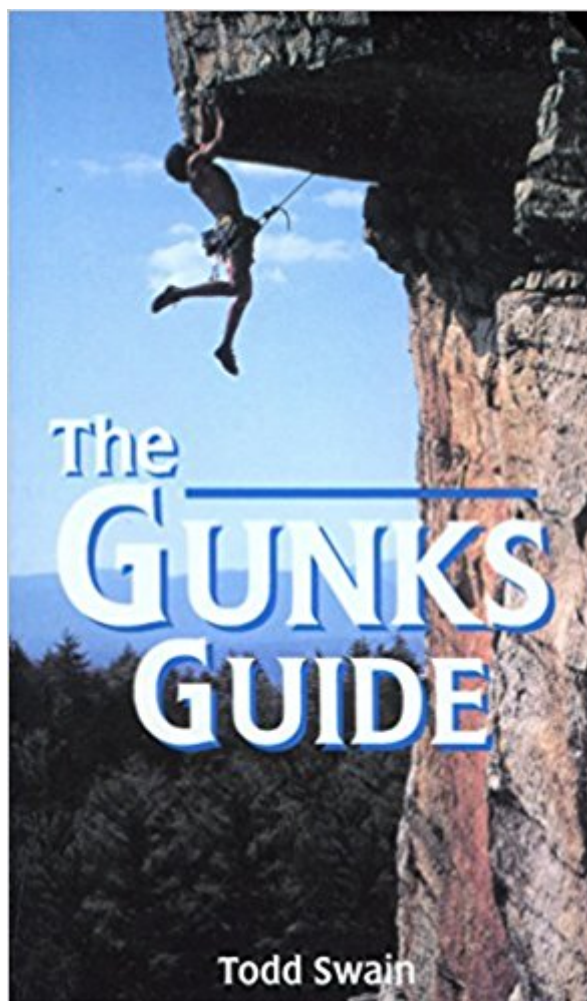

Completely updated, the Gunks Guide is the comprehensive rock climbers' guidebook to 1200 Shawangunk routes.

This book is nice. Only thing that could have made this a 5 star book was if it had been in color - but then - I only know of 1 GUNKS guidebook being in color (The Gunks by Zach Orencak & Rachael Lynn - which can be hard to find). Otherwise this book is great. Great pics, diagrams, charts, maps, etc. A DEF must if you want to climb the Gunks! If combined with the above guidebook as well, you have a def kick butt combo for finding routes, reading about GUNKS history, and even some 70's retro pics of some famous climbers as well. The color pics from Orencak & Lynn's book help a lot in actually 'locating' the correct route(s), and different sections of the GUNKS such as a Trapps, Near Traps, etc.
