

Read as part of 'global challenge', this is a really well-written travel book. First published in 1990, the author describes his exploration of this largely unknown country - from his arrival in the capital, Nouakachott, with the encroaching sand; to the Moorish peoples of the desert. He visits a ruined city, meets fishermen who fish with the dolphins, and becomes aware of the tensions between black and white Mauritanians. As another reviewer observes, there isn't a lot of 'action', but Peter Hudson's descriptions of these remote towns and their inhabitants are vividly depicted. Contains a few line drawings and b/w photos.
