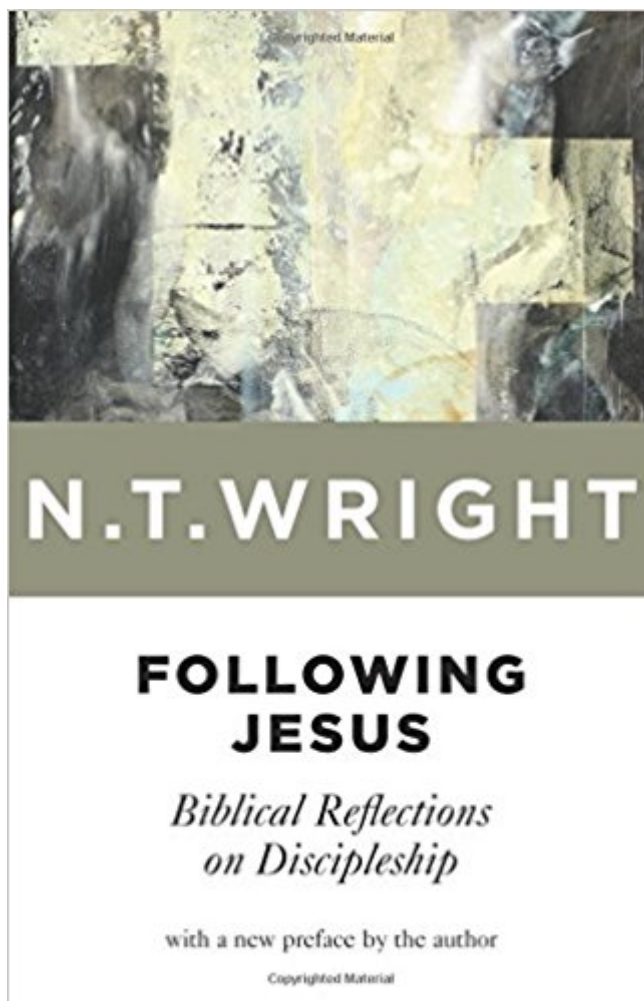

Following Jesus: Biblical Reflections On Discipleship



Synopsis

Featuring a brand-new cover design, this edition of N. T. Wright's popular *Following Jesus* -- first published in 1995 -- includes a new preface in which Wright reflects on the book's origin and significance for him personally and on its continued relevance to believers even though our global context has changed. Wright first outlines the essential messages of six major New Testament books -- Hebrews, Colossians, Matthew, John, Mark, and Revelation -- looking in particular at their portrayal of Jesus and what he accomplished in his sacrificial death. In the second part of the book Wright takes six key New Testament themes -- resurrection, rebirth, temptation, hell, heaven, and new life in a new world -- and considers their significance for the lives of present-day disciples.

N. T. (Tom) Wright is Professor of New Testament and Early Christianity at the University of St. Andrews, Scotland, and one of the most highly respected biblical scholars in the world today.

Although this collection of sermons comes from sermons preached in the early 90's, it offers a fresh voice and a welcome complement to Wright's more recent and current offerings. These are brief transcripts of sermons that offer overviews of several books of the New Testament and then a series of transcripts on Christian themes. The sermons are well adapted for the book. I think readers who are new to Wright and those who have read everything else in the Wright portfolio will find stimulating, enlightening and challenging writing in this book. The Biblical reflections will help readers have a better understanding of these topics and will translate into better following of Jesus. Some of Wright's book can be complex and difficult for readers to follow. This book is written for the congregation that includes non-Christians and Christians of various maturity, so it is very accessible and easy to follow. I think any reader will appreciate this contribution to discipleship.

Not Wright's best work by any means. I understand that they are little reflections, but he begins each chapter with an illustration then strains to find an application in Scripture. Unfortunately, much of today's bad preaching is done the same way. Rather than exegete the text properly, there is an application and illustration taken first, and then a grasping for a Scripture to use to make it relevant.
