

After five years of marriage, she was alone with a 4-year-old daughter and the attorney bills from Bobby's divorce. Not being one to bemoan her fate, she picked herself up and got a job as a housemaid for another 'bad boy' movie star, Rick Shade. Asked to bring him coffee, she overhears him discussing with his manager how to get out of his current scrape. His manager suggests he marry air-head Vickie Castle. Rick says, no, he'd rather marry her, the maid. He pushes the idea of a 1-year marriage of convenience, offering her enough money to pay off her debts and have some left over. Victorine has done it again with

another installment of her 'married' series. Don't miss it.

Desperate times call for desperate measures. Tara McDermott thought taking a job as a maid was desperate.
