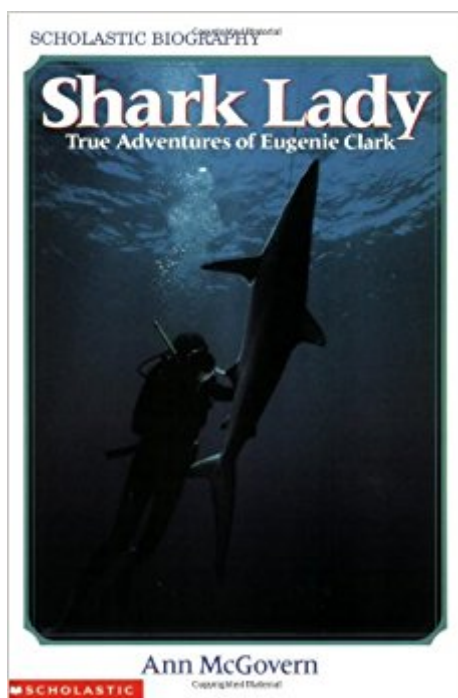

Ann McGovern has been writing children's books for over 35 years. She has published over 45 titles including STONE SOUP, several books in the IF YOU LIVED.... series, and SCRAM, KID! (Viking, 1974), which won the Horn Book Award. McGovern spent part of her career at Scholastic, where she created the See-Saw Book Club. McGovern lives in New York City.

My 9 yr old had to choose an autobiography for a school book report and we randomly chose this one from a level based reading list and reviews, not knowing anything about Eugenie. I don't think we could have picked a better book. The book isn't very long, and is well written so was a quick read, 9yo read it twice the first weekend we had it. We both enjoyed learning about Eugenie's

fascination with marine science at a young age and then how she worked hard and followed her dreams make a career out of what she loved to do. I love the short note at the end of the book by Dr. Clark encouraging kids to do what they love, even if it's nothing to do with marine science. Great lesson, great book.
