

It was initially supposed to be a temporary move--a change of scenery for a while--but 10 years and a couple of adopted street dogs later, bustling BogotÃ_i has gradually become their home. Excited to share his newfound insider perspective on Colombia with others, Andrew traveled the country corner to corner to research Moon Colombia. Colombia has experienced great change during the past decade, transforming itself from a no-go to a must-see destination. Andrew is continuously astounded by the natural beauty of the country and touched by the genuine warmth of its people.

this is handy little guide for "take along" purposes, but there's not a lot here that you can't get online. i would have appreciated more insider-type tips, given the author's personal background. i purchased the book for it's 130+ pages on bogota; about 1/2 the book is dedicated to day trips and ideas for things to do outside the city.

This has the exact same information as the Moon "Colombia" book does on Bogot \tilde{A}_i . It does not go into any more detail, which I was hoping when I bought it. It isn't bad, but it isn't the most thorough. I would have liked more up-to-date information, more maps, a better description of the public transportation system in Bogot \tilde{A}_i (and maps), and more recommended dining options for various budgets.
