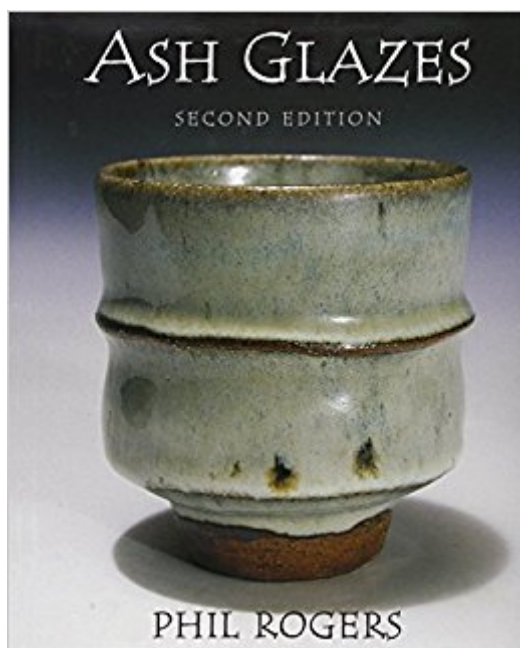

I was surprised at how much useful information is found in this book. The author not only covers ash glazes but the interactions of glaze materials that can apply to any potter interested in glazes in general. While most of the photos I've seen of ash glazes are mostly similar, the author introduces the use of ash as a powerful ingredient for use in glazes not normally associated with them.
