

This tale isn't a save the Abbey sort of tale but rather one about a young crippled here learning true strength comes for within and others around you. The tales of Redwall never fail to enchant me. From the islands beyond the sea, across the sands of the Mountain stronghold Salamandastron to the forest of Mossflower, Jacques paints an eloquent picture of his fictitious world, drawing you into the story itself and making you feel part of the action. The different dialects with which characters speak, the sumptuous descriptions of great feasts, the harrowing tales of war, tragedy and loss and the colorful and delightful characters make this series an absolute joy to read. The series as a whole is worth the read-including this special tale, of a wheelchair bound hare maid on a journey to find a cure to her disability. I'll let you find out the ending on your own!
