

It was cheaper to rent this textbook for one of my college courses instead of buying it or renting it from other websites. It served its purpose in helping me throughout the course as directed by my professor.

Although technically "not to be sold in the US," the global paperback edition is in essence identical to the US version, with the advantage of weighing less. The only difference I came across while

using it for class was one problem where my version described a shop selling fish and chips and the original used ice cream. Keep in mind having an unauthorized addition does limit your sell back options though! I didn't think about that. But I have found a couple online places who say they'll take it.

The paperback version is a LOT less expensive than the hard cover version. I bought this book for a graduate course, and I have learned so much. The material is understandable. Make sure you read all the blue and yellow sections! The review questions at the end of each chapter are very helpful as well.

Its a college textbook I bought for one of my classes. So far at least, it has been a big help to me in learning Accounting Information Systems. It is organized in such a way that makes learning this subject less difficult. Price was reasonable.
