This book emphasizes cancer research using dogs - but not as test objects. (This isn't beagles in cages in laboratories.) Instead, in "comparative oncology", dogs are given new medicines in trials, but only up until the point where quality of life is no longer there. The book is easy to follow for the non-scientist. The discussion of how pharma (big and small) determine how and what to investigate was informative. I was less interested in the time she spent discussing her sister's (very sad) cancer case, which was what got her started investigating this area. It did serve to underscore the difference between her sister's continued suffering through various unsuccessful treatment and the compassionate care given to the dogs. (In my experience, veterinarians generally are kinder to their patients than people docs. *Generalization based upon personal experience!*) One qualm is how quickly it may be out of date ...

It's obvious a lot of research & hard work has been put into writing this book, but the author presents it in the most fascinating & comprehensible way possible. And powerfully too: Weintraub integrates her own family experience with cancer. Yet the message throughout is positive & hopeful. Who knew pet dogs (& cats too) are playing such an important role in helping researchers & doctors learn more about treating & curing so many different cancers in both animals & humans? Now we do.

Heal is a beautifully written, as well as concise book dealing with the role of dogs as regards to human and animal cancers. The author gently informs the reader of the battle and emotions in losing her own sister to this disease, and how and why she became involved in this educational writing endeavor. Arlene Weintraub is a gifted and sensitive author; I have learned so much from this outstanding book!
