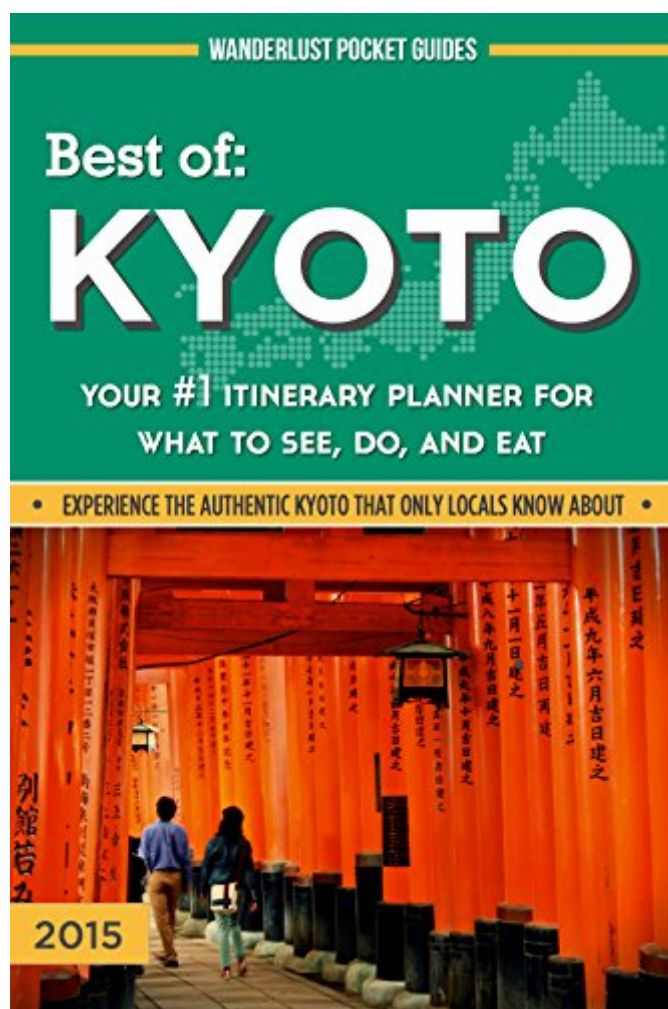

This is not only the worst travel book I have ever purchased, it is the worst travel book I have ever seen. Any Positive reviews MUST be ghost writers for Wanderlust company. I have traveled for 50

years and used innumerable travel books. I have used some very concise travel books that hit only the highlights, but this book is totally ridiculous as it basically says nothing. And has NO color pictures on the inside - that is a first to see only grainy black and white photos. Do NOT even think of purchasing this book despite its low cost.

This guidebook appears to have been cut-and-pasted off of the internet and printed using 's Createspace self-publishing platform. There is no named author or editor, but given the numerous problems with the poorly-written and uninformative text, slipshod layout, and lousy maps, it's fair to state that whoever edited this book is incompetent. The four- and five-star ratings were clearly bought. Lastly, even if you did find it worth carrying to Japan, it's not even pocket-sized. [Note: as befits this publisher, I have cut-and-pasted this review from my review of the Wanderlust Best of Tokyo guide.]

I bought this book, trusting the 5* reviews. I should not have. This book is useless as anything other than a very cursory overview of the city. It has little useful travel information. No maps (beyond a broad city overview, taken from Wikipedia), no transportation information. It gives brief overviews of tourist attractions and a few places to eat, but little information beyond what you could find online. I think Wikipedia would have been a better source for information about the city than this book. I had hoped to save a few dollars by buying this book, but am returning it and will buy Lonely Planet.

I didn't find this book to be particularly helpful for planning our trip to Kyoto. The recommendations are based off of one person's set of experiences in the city, and a much broader perspective can be gained through browsing blogs, special interests websites and other resources without having to pay for something to carry around with you.

You can get much more meaningful information from simply typing "Kyoto" into google. This book contains very little in the way of helpful travel tips or the individual characteristics or history of Kyoto's many temples and cultural sites.

The information is good, but it's quite basic. I was hoping for a more in depth guide.

Contains basic list of the top X places you must visit or do or eat at. Internet search will yield much better results. I just ditched the book and used gokyoto.com site.
