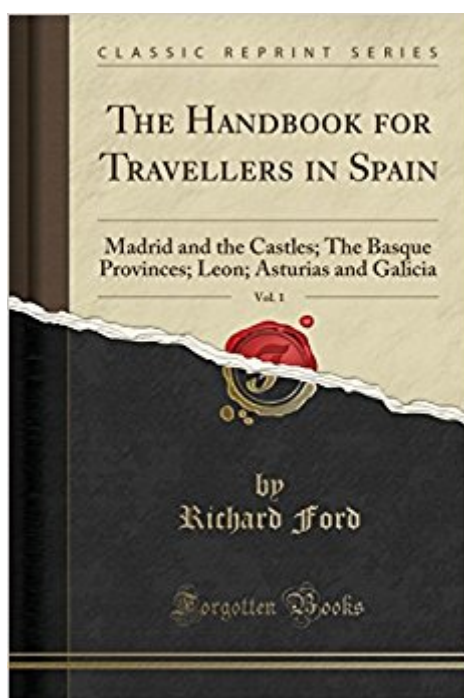

Unlike run of the mill language translations, Ford is able to intuitively identify phrases that would be most apt in different situations and locations and provides functional translation for these in English. His detailed analysis of Madrid is particularly impressive as it dives into the history, art and architecture of the place rather than providing just a superficial overview.
