

Recognize it and have a reference to the page with a very detailed and well-illustrated description. There is a brief, but thorough Introduction explaining the biological life zones of the Rockies. A typical description provides the name including the Latin including the typical size in both in Imperial and Metric. Each feature has a $2\tilde{A} \notin \hat{A}$ \hat{A} (approx.) full color illustration. The description provided is clear. For mammals, birds, fish and reptiles there are details on habit and behavior. For trees and herbs the description includes the height, needle/leaf length with information about flowers / fruit where relevant.
