

Printed on waterproof, tear-tough paper. This map covers the huge core of Grand Canyon National Park. This is the area where 99% of visitors travel and where 90% of overnight backcountry trips take place, and where most trails and reliable water sources are. The map does not cover the vast and more isolated western sections, nor the far NE corner. (Zoom into the inset maps above to see exact coverage.) Includes a handy and concise bus map. Durable, easy to use. I love how prominent landmarks along the trail are marked. I recognize the contours, but I like to see the feature's name on it. Everyone hiking in the GC should carry a good

topo map like this one.

This version has so much information packed into a small space, you could plan and hike without anything else. Campgrounds labeled, water sources indicated, distances between points calculated and listed in an easy to read format. On my last hike my friend had the Nat Geo map and I carried this. I could pick out our location just as easily but I also had instant access to additional information. I especially liked the small square on the back to help identify the various rock layers by color. It helped us keep the canyon in perspective vertically and horizontally. Would buy it again.

I would not think of ever going into the canyon without this map. The maps provided at the Grand Canyon National park are horrible. This map was extremely accurate. If there this any critizism that I have about the map, the difficulty levels must have been set by someone that hikes the canyon a lot. When you see an M for "Moderate Difficulty" think of yourself as a twenty year old in great shape. That is who thinks those areas of the canyon are of moderate difficulty.

I love maps, and this one is super! It's also packed with regional and site information, including trail descriptions and water availability information. Great map.

This is my favorite Grand Canyon map. The large scale makes it easy to read, and the detail is perfect.
