

The format is easy to follow and takes you on a journey. My passions in the world are in bringing in the new paradigm where there is a balance and equality in our masculine and feminine relationships as well as the relationship between human and nature. This book also covers how we can learn to pleasure ourselves and our intimate partners. It even addresses how we can honor and respect each other so we are uplifting each other and honoring ourselves at the same time. It feels very appropriate at these times when so many confusion exists in relationship.

I just started to read the book, and I am already thankful. I too was pretty much left in limbo regarding sexual relations when I was growing up. I got the church's doctrine on the matter: don't do it...you'll get someone pregnant...it's a sin to even think about it...oh, and it is also a sin to explore your own body through masturbation. There was no practical guidance from church, parents, or teachers as I stumbled through my sexual experiences and wondered why my experiences didn't measure up to those displayed in the popular media (advertising, movies, magazines, etc.). Emotional and physical sexual development for me was done in the dark and always with a mental battle as to whether I should even be exploring this aspect of my personality. Some sort of mentoring process would have been very beneficial. Actually, In fact, I am sure it would still be beneficial since being mid-aged now I feel as though I have just barely scratched the surface of my sexual potential. I guess that is why I searched and found Quodoushka. The first chapter of the book has made me keenly aware of the source of my fairly recent feelings of being an insufficient parent for my young teenage children. This wasn't a problem when they were younger, but I have difficulty now as they are starting to think about the opposite sex and sex in general. I would really like to give my kids some guidance other than the rhetoric and limbo I was given at that age, but I haven't known how to even begin. Too much information before they are ready for it could be just as damaging as too little. Thankfully, I am also realizing from the text that I have already started my children on a solid path through my introducing them to nature and showing them the value of being observant in life and a good steward at home, school, and in the world. I am looking forward to learning much more about my sexual and parental potentials as I continue to read this wonderful book of knowledge.

I found it to be very good and enjoyed it a lot. It had some good information and exercises and very stimulating.

The principals in this book are interesting but seemed to be, ironically, putting sexuality into boxes. Also I found very little of the information to be helpful as a gay man.

Isn't it odd and refreshing to hear someone who is espousing a particular point of view say, "Don't believe this because I told you; only believe it if it actually works for you." Every Q teaching begins -"Don't believe anything we tell you unless it grows corn for you?" A little background: I am a master sceptic. I argue with people for a living, so you can be sure that I doubted almost everything I heard at my first Q workshop (and, actually, there are still some minor elements of the teaching that I am sceptical of). But I can tell you without a doubt that by the time I read this book, I was convinced that Quodoushka grows corn for me, and for others, exceptionally well. I know, I know to my very core, that these teachings are incredibly powerful and a great salve for much of what ails us as individuals and as a species: mindless acceptance of control by others; a philosophy that says if you don't believe in my God and yield to its earthly adminstrators, then there is something wrong with you; an inability to respect and accept others with all their magnificent variety. If that is too grand a claim for you, then please don't believe it. If the socially acceptable and socially conditioned life is working for you, if you are a fully realized human being who is authentically connected to those around you, then you may not need what Quodoushka has to offer. But, if there is something in your life that is not working and you don't know how to fix it, then what do you lose by finding out about the Q teachings to see if they might help you. And it cannot fairly be debated that this book is a great way to start the process of discovering what Quodoushka has to offer. If the book leads you to a Q teaching with an open mind, you may discover, as I and thousands of others have discovered, that the teachings do grow corn for you. For a few dollars you can own this book and isn't that a worthwhile test ride for such a grand prize? So about the book... First of all, it is a basic introduction to the subject matter. But even so, it is full of insight that you won't find anywhere else. Why has

nobody ever taught you about anatomy types? Because they don't know, that's why. This book (and/or a Q workshop) will show you why and how your anatomy type sets out a smorgasbord of pleasurable possibility, if you only know which buttons to push. You'll learn how understanding your anatomy type and that of your partner opens the door to a great new relationship based on knowledge and insight. Those answers are right here in this book. The book is beautifully written and is easy to understand. It foregoes complex language and all those uncomfortable latin words and replaces them with simple, plain speaking that anyone can understand. The underlying Quodoushka philosophy might be vast and deep, but this book will get you started by providing you with digestible morsels that explain why so many relationships are underperforming at best and destined to fail at worst. Amara has distilled many hours of teaching into the book and done so with a perfect blend of explanation and exposition. So is there something rotten in Quodoushka? I ask this: How many times have you heard vehement criticism of something only to find that the critic had not read the book, not seen the film, not studied the problem and so on. Sure, the critic may hold firm convictions, but until that person has given the book and the program a chance, a review is premature.

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
