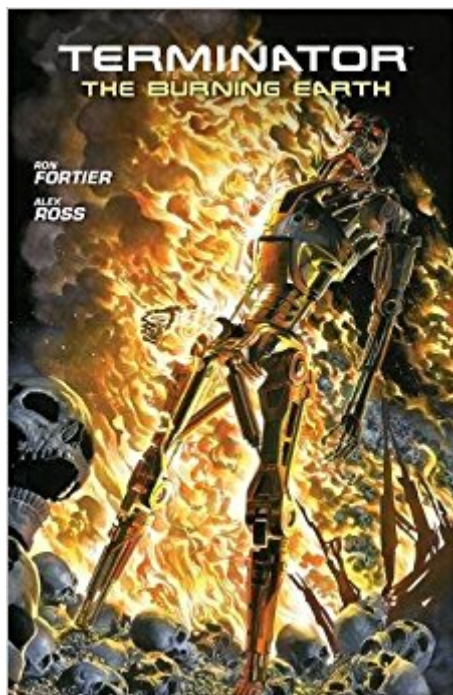

Best Terminator comic ever done, for fans of the films. Better than anything Dark Horse did with the franchise, and far better than NOW Comics’ regular monthly Terminator series at the time. Ross’ work is great here, rivals anyone else’s painted comic work. His characters and set pieces remain consistent and very cinematic throughout. My only issues are technical on the part of whoever put the whole thing together over his artwork. The lettering looks quite poor in the word balloons, so much so that it actually does detract from the overall work; I mean normally, who cares, but it’s pretty glaringly unprofessional as it was done. Plus, the printing, or I guess the way the original pages were scanned in or photographed (or whatever process was used) seems out of focus pretty often, or softened overall. Remember this comic was put out by "NOW comics" and Tony Caputo, and as I understand, they had a history of some printing and production problems, which is a shame, because occasionally they had really great stuff like this. I guess this is the best this material

will ever look; I'd hoped that this redux version would have cleared up more of these production issues. That being said, it's still great to look at and the story is quite good, and it will definitely take you back into the world of what the Terminator films hinted at, so I'd recommend it highly, in spite of its production-related shortcomings. And I think this was actually Ross' first published work. Man, that guy is good!

I really liked this. It was very simple. Only took me an hour to read. I wish more graphic novels were like this. Not trying to explain in detail the story through the dialogue. It's fast moving and you piece it together as you go along. With a good introduction and afterword. Love the art. Some panels were hard to make out so use your imagination.
