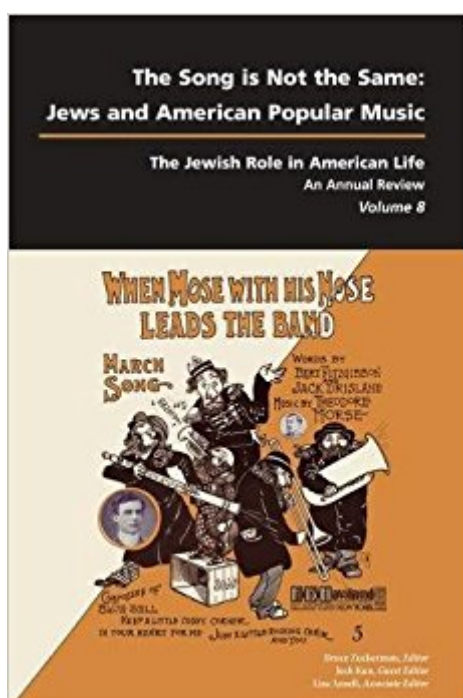

His research focuses on the arts and politics of cultural connection, with an emphasis on popular music, the cultures of globalization, the US-Mexico border, and Jewish American musical history. of English at the University of California, Riverside. He holds a PhD in Ethnic Studies from University of California, Berkeley. He received his Ph.D. in ancient Near Eastern languages from Yale University. She was the Chair of the World Language Department of New Community Jewish High School for five years before coming to USC in August, 2007.
