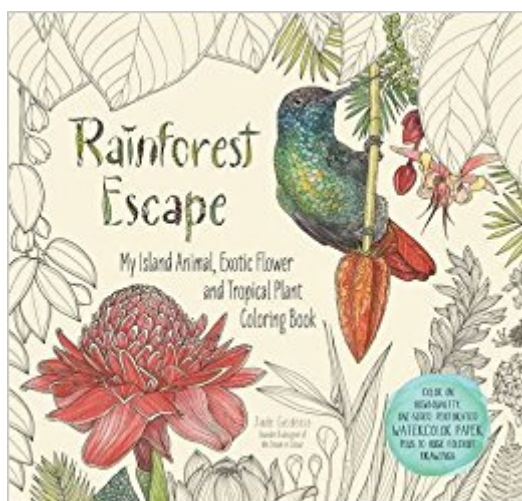

Summary:"Rainforest Escape" contains approx. 49 full size images, 5 pages of introductory material, a 5 page index in the back, and a single page of author information. It measures 9 x 9.5 inches and is sewn into a heavy textured cover with a lay flat binding. Featuring line drawings of rainforest plants and animals, this book is appropriate for adult colorists on all skill levels.Paper:The paper in this book is cream colored and very heavy(like watercolor paper). All pages are single sided and perforated. All mediums should be okay to use, but be sure to place several sheets of blotter paper under your picture if you use markers.Artwork:As the title implies, "Rainforest Escape" focuses on botanicals and wildlife found in the rainforests of the Caribbean. Inside you'll see birds, lizards, plants, tropical drinks, jaguars, patterns, and more. Some of the images are fully illustrated with foreground and background elements, while others are composed of several smaller pieces. The majority of the pictures are the size of a single page, but there are around 10 fold-out double page spreads as well. All artwork does end before entering the binding, so it can be removed without compromising anything. Detail level varies a bit throughout and there are a few messy areas in the printing(probably due to the type of paper used). Picture completion time should range from 3-8 hours(may be slightly different for each individual). Overall, this is a nicely composed book with lots of really great features. It would be best suited for colorists who enjoy island scenery/plants and peaceful imagery.

I recently purchased Jade Gedeon's first coloring book primarily to learn how to use water colors. As soon as I received it, I purchased a second copy and then pre-ordered two copies of Rainforest Escape. It is really just that good. I want to be able to color one book with colored pencils and use the second one for my learning purposes.In this new book Ms. Gedeon

explores the plants and animals of her tropical experiences (the previous book focused considerably on architecture.) The designs remind me of my own tropical vacations in the Caribbean, Hawaii, and even Bali. There is a lush feeling to the vegetation that makes me remember how it felt to actually be in a rainforest environment. The paper is a cream tone and is heavyweight watercolor paper. There are ten double page fold-out designs. All of the pages are perforated for easy removal from the book. While the book is sewn binding, none of the designs cross over the perforations. If you want to remove pages to frame them, you won't lose any portion of the design in taking the page out via the perforations. I found, once again, that all of my coloring medium worked well with this paper. The only issue I had was with some of my Copic markers that were extremely full and *juicy*. With those, there was a slight tendency for feathering. This is what I experienced in coloring in this book and testing my coloring medium on the paper. I didn't test any form of watercolor medium as I am just learning how to use it. Because of that, I shy away from saying how it worked for me as any issues I come across are sure to be because of my inexperience rather than any issue with the book. I will provide a list of the coloring medium I use for testing and for most of my coloring projects in the comments section below.

Lush and Exotic Rainforest inspired Artwork Designs
Printed on one side of the page with ten double page fold-out designs
Paper is thick watercolor paper in cream, rough texture and all pages are perforated for easy removal.
Sewn Binding
Designs stop short of perforations
Alcohol-based markers bleed through the page and can feather side-to-side if the marker is *juicy*.
Water-based markers, India ink pens, and gel pens do not bleed through the paper. Gel pens dry exceptionally quick with this paper.
Colored pencils work well with the page though, due to the texture, it takes several layers to get a deep pigment. Both oil and wax based pencils worked equally well. I was able to get good color, layer different colors easily and blend extremely easily using a pencil style blender stick.

This is a beautiful book meant for watercolorists. The paper works well as long as you don't try to over saturate the paper. Colored pencils work okay on the paper but this is really meant for watercolors. The images are pretty and interesting. The pages are all perforated so it makes it easier to work with each page and not ruin the page beneath with the paint or water. As I complete pages I will add them to this review. Also if my opinion changes on the book due to use of a certain material or the like I will add that as well.

This is how a coloring book should be done!!! High quality paper & lovely uneven edges! Not only is the art work so amazing but each page image is printed on one side and double pages are fold outs

instead of printing thru a staple or part of the image in the binding itself! I am looking forward to lots of fun with this creative book. I have already ordered her other book out "Island Escape" and it is formatted the same way.LOVE IT!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

These are really beautiful drawings on heavy paper that is perfect for watercolors. The paper actually feels like cloth. It says that the paper is suitable for watercolors but the drawings seemed a little too fine for watercolors.The two page drawings are on foldout pages.

When I ordered this book, I expected the beautifully intricate drawings that fill its pages. What blew me away was the incredibly luxurious paper. I've never seen anything like it!
