

Exactly what I was looking for. I bought a lot of practice Italian books that used too many words that were not defined so I had no idea what they meant. This book gives you a list of the words you will be conjugating and their meanings I had a previous verb drill book that gave you a small list and then went on to use words not on the list. I had no idea what they meant. What would be the use of conjugating words I do not understand. This book is great for beginners who need practice or for those who have to brush up after not using the language for too many years and have forgotten manyy words and how to conjugate. I and I wish it were the first one I bought when I was fist studying Italian.

I am a beginner trying to teach myself Italian. After playing with Duolingo for a while, I wanted something that explains grammar and conjugation better. This book has a simple, easy approach. It teaches you a simple concept and a few rules of conjugation, and then you can drill on those for 4-5 practices. Learn, drill, repeat. In the process, you learn a lot of verbs too! The only thing I wish it

contains some example sentences, since the dictionary translations are sometimes the same for different verbs. For example, "abitare" and "vivere" both means "to live", but I am usually not sure which to use given the context.

This is a very well done book, with very clear explanations of the verb tenses and good tips. I would advise that you use a notebook to do the exercises because you will need to do all of them more than once to get the full benefit. The answer key is a critical component of this book because it allows you to check your work. The only small criticism that I have is in the proofreading of the answer key - there are a few errors in it, but they will be obvious and are not detrimental to the overall use of the book.

The good points about this book are that it has plenty of verbs in all the conjugations. The verb classes (-are, -ere, -ire) and the irregulars are covered well. The downside of the book, in my opinion, is its poor instructional design. The index is a glaring example. It does not reference page numbers, rendering it almost must useless as a a look up table for various occurences of verb forms and specifically irregular forms in the text. The reader must literally scour the text to find specific verb information as a result. In terms of content, a good book. As an instructional aid, I have reservations about its design.

I have purchased many versions of these books in several different languages for my high school children to learn languages. They really like the workbook style of book. The instructions are all in English, so it is easy for them to understand what they need to do. It consists of filling in the blank type problems and choosing the correct answer from a list. The answers to the problems are at the end of the book, so they can determine if they got the answer right or wrong. The only downside is that they are not able to listen to the spoken language, but that is the case with most language books. I feel that these books have helped them greatly and I would recommend to others.

This is a great book to study Italian verbs from. Very well written and laid out in an easy to follow format. I've been teaching myself Italian and this book has definitely come in handy. Buy it used and its an even better deal...

If you are having any sort of trouble with verbs in Italian, look no further. This book really drills it in you, and it really makes you feel more confident when you conjugate the verbs on-the-fly when speaking. Every conjugation has examples and tons of self-tests which will have you writing English-Italian, and vice versa. For example, it will say 'I speak', and you will translate it to 'io parlo', and again it will say something else like 'noi ci laviamo', and you will translate that to English. Also, there is an answer key in the back so you can correct yourself. For the price, you cannot find anything better, and if you do, let me know so I can buy whatever it is as well!
