I admire anyone who can write a book and have it published; so well done, Mr. Breakfield. But as another reviewer noted, the author just tries too hard to be witty and clever. It becomes less about the subject matter and more about trying to turn a phrase which, in my opinion, he fails to do. But I hope he keeps writing because it's a worthy pursuit and he can improve with time and practice.
