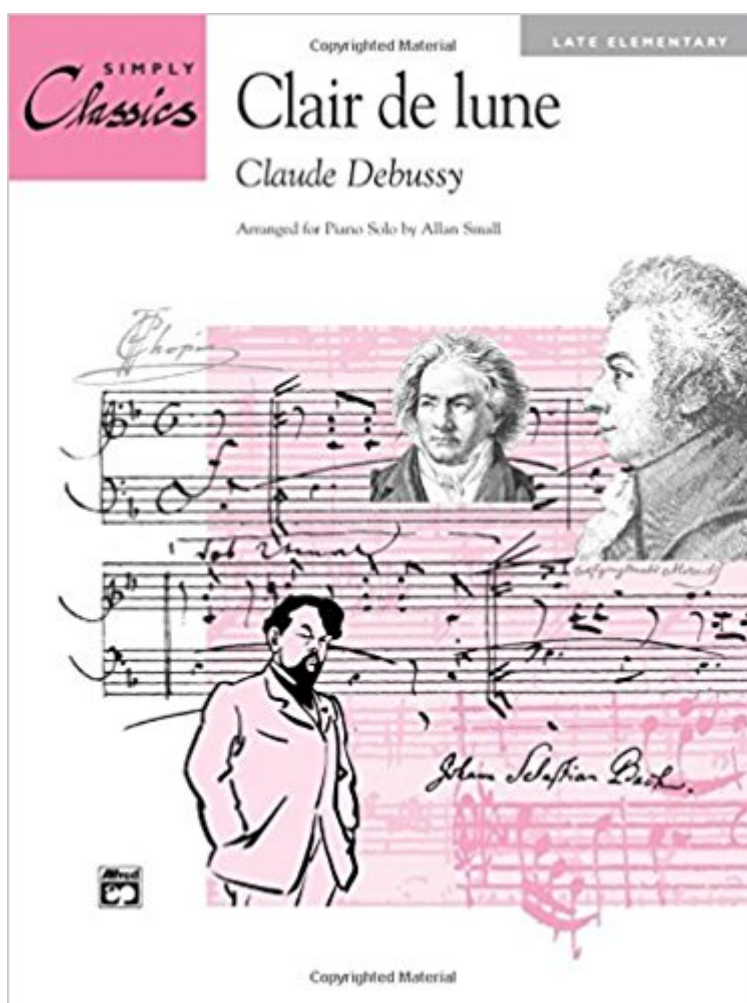

Clair De Lune: From Suite Bergamasque, Sheet (Simply Classics Solos)



Synopsis

Simplified Masterwork Solo version of one of Debussy's most popular piano works. This ethereal, flowing section of Suite Bergamasque is diatonic and displays a conventional harmonic vocabulary, transposed to the Key of C. The title, Clair de lune, suggests a relationship to Paul Verlaine's eponymous poem, describing a vision of long-dead dancers in the moonlight. The music transmits the otherworldly, transparent, and impalpable qualities of the experience while maintaining clarity and definition. Perfect for the burgeoning late elementary pianist.

I bought this hoping for some fingering help but there was no original finger markings so you'll be hard pressed to find a copy with them. Nice clear indications and easy to read.

I like this piano piece because it is a beautiful piece that is easy enough for a Late Beginner/Early Intermediate pianist to handle. It does require understanding of holding tied notes through opposing melody lines, hands over skill, and changing clef signs...but I find it to be an excellent 'dessert piece' for students to show off with! The 'Simply Classics' Series is an excellent one.
