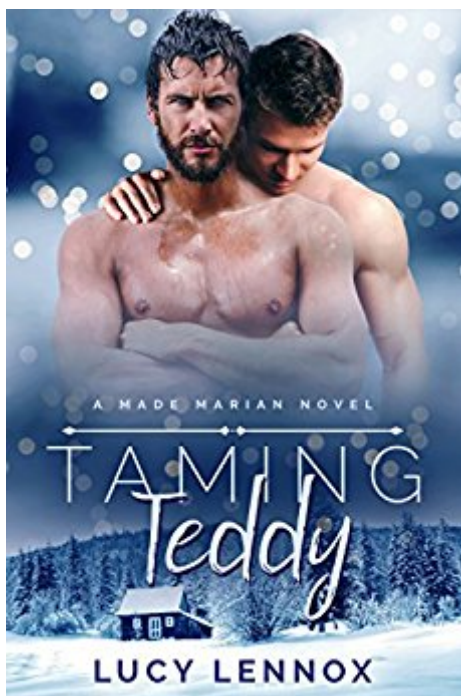

After reading four and a half books in this series, I think this one is my favorite. Number one, I'm an amateur nature photographer so Teddy's job spoke to me. Number two, I'm enthralled with wildlife so Jamie's job spoke to me as well. But even more than that, the way they were together and their love story was simply wonderful. :) This one actually had that little bit of pizzazz and emotional connection I need to rate it five stars. I understand holding someone at arm's length at first only to have that ultimately fail in the end and end up falling head over heels in love. There's nothing like it in the world, especially when that person loves you back. The characters in this series are just wonderful. They're well-rounded, complex, and developed. The author has thought about it enough to give them all adequate back stories and it's a joy to read. The descriptions of the settings are great. I never have any trouble imagining where we are and yet they're not so descriptive that they're boring. Ms. Lennox does an excellent job with that balance. The plot line moves along at a steady pace. I never felt that it was dragging, but I never felt that it was going too fast either. All in all this book is just about perfect! While it can be read as a stand-alone, I highly recommend reading the series from the beginning, starting with *Borrowing Blue*. Try it and have fun with the Made Marian crew!

Jamie was so sure that he wanted to have nothing to do with Teddy, who's a nature photographer that wants to feature Jamie, who's known as the wildlife whisperer. But Teddy does not give up or take no for an answer. I loved how relentless he was and how Jamie kept coming back to that personality trait at the end of the story. I love stories where the heroes are stuck in snowstorms. This entire book kind of fell under that feel. Jamie lives in the middle of the Alaskan wilderness. It's pretty darn remote and inaccessible and these two guys are stuck there together. Yes...that does translate to happy times. I like how Jamie is slowly brought around to Teddy's way of thinking. It's not a sudden thing, although their attraction is. But he seriously underestimates Teddy. Their jobs are so complimentary. And can I just say how much I thoroughly enjoyed getting to see into the inner sanctum of both their jobs. I loved that little glimpse into these careers. I'm loving this series. I really

enjoy this author's style of writing and her story-telling. It's the perfect style for audiobooks and this narrator does a fantastic job with her books. I liked it.

Dr. James Marian is a veterinarian and wildlife whisperer working in Denali Natl. Park, Alaska. Five months previously he was left at the alter by his ex Brian (who's already married), and he's now wary of trust and very lonely. Theodore "Teddy" Kodiak is an award winning wildlife photographer from NY, who wants to take photo shots of Jamie closely interacting with wild animals. Jamie says no, but Teddy won't be deterred, and tricks his way into Jamie's home. They are intensely attracted to each other, but the thousand miles separating them is problematic, including trust issues. What I loved about this story is the writers descriptive ability to let me enjoy the beauty of Alaska, and these wild animals appear to be up close and personal with myself. The book is also rampant with humorous dialogue. Jamie and Teddy, both of who's interests are in wildlife, are perfect for each other. They slowly shed their trust and commitment issues after several disagreements, and have a hot sexy HEA. I also enjoy Jamie's extended family, and Teddys close friends.

I bought the rest of the books in the Made Marian Series after finishing Borrowing Blue and loving the characters. Dr. James Marian, wildlife veterinarian, and Teddy Kodiak, wildlife photographer, are the two main characters. This book isn't as freewheeling as Borrowing Blue. The main action takes place in Denali National Park, Alaska. The descriptions of the wilderness and the animals are so vivid you can almost see them. Teddy wants to take the perfect Gramling Prize winning photo of Jamie, the wildlife whisperer, and he's driving Jamie crazy emailing and calling. The whole Marian clan gets in on the story and picks up Tristan and Blue's story. Jamie is hurting from being literally left at the alter on his wedding day. Teddy is a love 'em and leave 'em first type. They get to happy ever after with some hot sex and fun along the way. The grannies are in there too! I liked this book even though it's more serious than the first story. I'm looking forward to reading the rest of them straight through.

I loved this second installment the give and take between Jamie and Teddy was soooo much fun. Watching these two fall all the while fighting it was equally amazing. I have read this book five times now (read the whole series actually) and now we gullet to enjoy the audio by a narrator who just knocks it out of the park. If you buy the book trust me and splurge for the accompanying audio you will not be sorry Michael Pauley does a stellar job. Save yourself the trouble and just buy the series cuz each story builds on each other and you will fall deeper and deeper for not just the MC's but

each member of the Marian clan.

I already hesitated when reading the blurb, but since it was free I decided to try it anyway. Nope. Not for me. I read only a few pages before deciding I didn't like the writing style. A lot of coarse language going on in those few pages that didn't have any function (I am not against strong language in a book at all, but this was too much for me).
