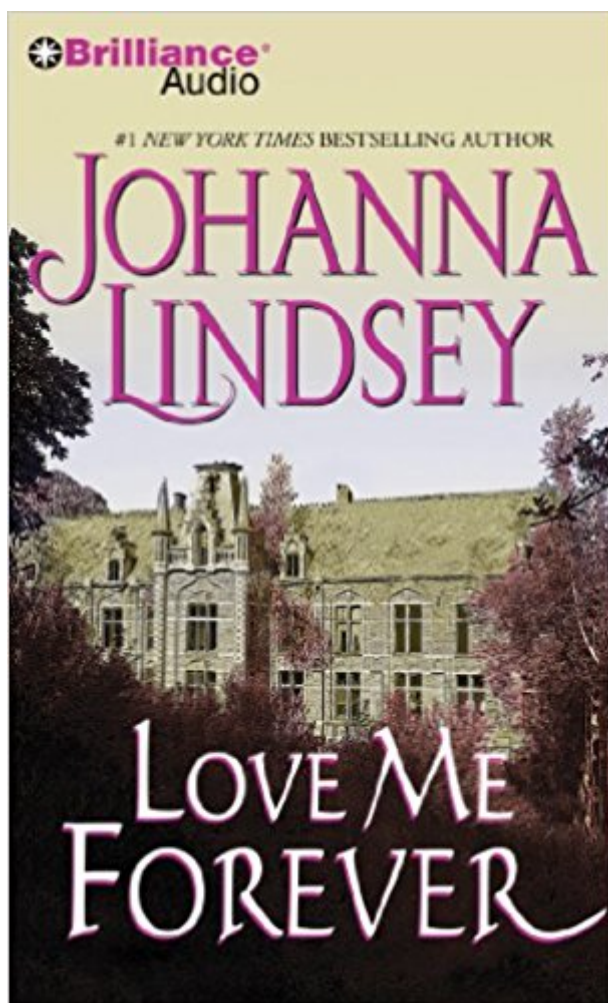

Many prefer the first in this series about Megan and Devlin but I don't. I think it is because Devlin is so incredibly arrogant that you want to pop him in the head. This is classic Lindsey, and many of her heroes are domineering and overbearing. Not so with Lachlan. He treats Kimberly with so much tenderness you want to have a Lachlan of your own! That is after you discount their first meeting. They both get off on the wrong foot with each other. The background characters are lively, the plot goes fast and you cannot turn the pages fast enough. I even have this book on audible so I can listen to it on my kindle.
