

I picked this book up for my 8th grader for an English assingment on Athena. As a history teacher, I love finding things for struggling readers, this and other graphic novels fit the bill for many who

This graphic novel was an excellent introduction to the history of Athena. Having just completed the Odyssey I wanted to read more about Athena and thought that my oldest boy would enjoy reading this too, and I was correct. It was a great read and fun and informative and appropriate to share with a 12 year-old. We both enjoyed it a lot.

I enjoyed this volume more than the volume on Aphrodite (in all fairness, that's probably because I like Athena more). These are fun, quick reads for fans of Greek mythology.
