

Today, National Geographic Maps continues this mission by creating the world's best wall maps, recreation maps, atlases, and globes which inspire people to care about and explore their world.

This is a VERY detailed and accurate trail map. Each trail section is marked with mileage. The name and location of each back country campsite and other amenities are clearly marked. It came in extremely handy for planning a trip to RMNP this coming August(2013). It's almost as though you're right there in the park. When I called for back country campsite reservations the Ranger was impressed with my knowledge of the area where I reserved considering I had never been there. When I told him I got the info from the Nat. Geo. map he immediately said "That's one of the best maps of the park there is." It's also very sturdy and has a water repelling coating to help it last longer. Looking forward to the trip and taking this map with me.

Used this map on a 4 day visit to RMNP. Found it very accurate and helpful in planning the trip there. Would highly recommend this map if planning a trip to "Rocky".

These NatGeo maps are the best I've found for everything from family vacations to backcountry hunting. Very well marked and a lot of info in one map for the money. They're hard to beat!

Great map of the park. High quality construction, beautiful imaging, and helpful symbols and markings. If you are going to just do some day hikes in the park, this map is excessive (that's what I did). However, it was very helpful for me to find which hikes I wanted to do while I was there. Make sure you pair this map with a good compass, otherwise a map will be of zero value (not even as TP due to the texture). I would buy this again and would recommend it to a friend.

Great map to get a general idea of where places are in the park. While it has ground contours on the map you better have really good eyes to read the contour labels. I will use this map for trip planning and carry it with me but also print out smaller scale maps of the areas we plan to hike off Google Earth with Earthmate topo over lays to have more detailed info.

Essentail to someone hiking RMNP. Never go out hiking without a map of the area, it could save your life. This is a heavy duty map, not like one of the cheap ones you'll get at the park office. This one is of a plastic material and will hold up very well and you don't need to worry about water damage. On one of the hikes we did, it was abnormally hot and we ended up running out of water. This could have turned into a very bad situation but because we were prepared, we knew we had approximately a mile more and we would run across a stream where we could purify water and continue on our hike. Well worth it.

I ordered this for our recent vacation in Rocky Mountain National Park. We spent a week out there and did a few day hikes. We used the heck out of this map to help decide which trails we wanted to hike, and to figure out how to get to them. We also used various books for input on trail ratings and descriptions, but this map gives you the whole picture of where the trails are and what the terrain is like. While we were on the trail, this map was very useful in helping us figure out where we were at any given time. I wouldn't hit the trail without this in my pack.
