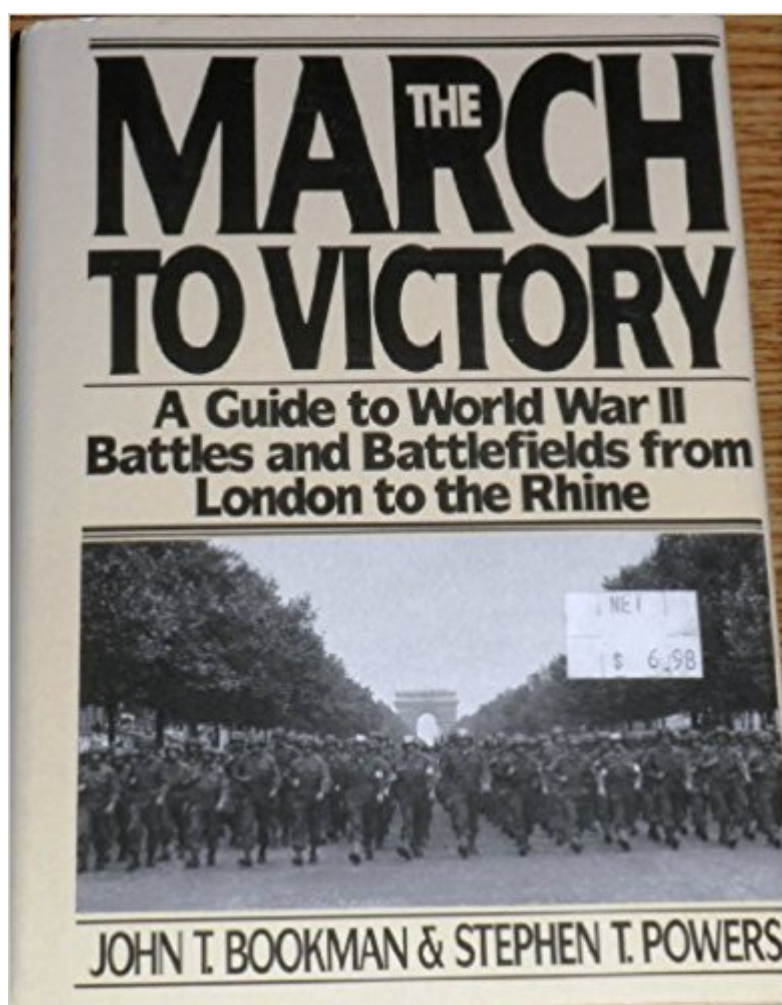

Combining history and guidebook, this is a description of World War II campaigns and battles of northwestern Europe. Having visited all the battlefields they describe, the authors tell not only how to get to each but what one may expect to find there now. Each section contains a brief history of the events that took place during the war and includes information on relics, monuments, and museums relating to the action. The book covers sites in England, France, Belgium, Luxembourg, Germany, and the Netherlands. Included is an annotated list of museums describing collections, hours, fees. Photos not seen. It's too bad this book is out of print, because I don't know of any other book like it. It's not only a

good introductory history of World War II in Europe, but an invaluable battlefield guide. If you're going to take a tour of WWII battlefields in western Europe, buy this book. The driving directions are superb. However, the maps are somewhat sparse and some of the route numbers have changed since the book was published, so you'll need to buy a good road atlas. I gave the book four stars because of the maps and it just covers Britain and Western Europe, but not Italy.
