

As a lover of gardening, this book has proven to be very helpful in choosing and planning for a beautiful display of irises for the coming spring. As a new collector of irises, I wanted an authoratative book that would help me to create a colorful display during the entire growing season and "The Gardener's Iris Book" taught me which plants to choose according to it's individual bloom season, height, color and re-bloom appeal. I look forward to becoming known as the "iris lady" on the block in the coming years.

This is definitely a book for a beginner. If you want some more detailed information, there are much better books such as the older but more comprehensive World of Irises. Pictures are very variable but many have annoying shadows and most could be improved by cropping. Some are shot are odd angles, giving sort of distorted views of the iris. The distribution of the text is very odd in that the very popular median classes of bearded irises are treated peripherally but there is a longer discourse on English and Juno irises that are hard to even obtain in the US and grow across a narrow climactic range, Some of the cultural information is suspect too.

This is a great over-all introduction to irises of all types, with specific instructions on planting and caring for all sorts of irises, but especially interesting to me because of the detailed instructions for caring for tall bearded irises. There are very good, clear recommendations for dealing with pests, planting, and fertilizing. I have been following this advice since I received the book and feel more confident about caring for my iris collection now.

There was a misunderstanding about what I ordered, but it was my fault. I appreciated the interest of Best Book Depot and in resolving this issue. I love the Book and would give Best Book Depot an excellent recommendation. This book is a classic and definitely one to keep as a reference for the future.

This book is full of practical advice on all aspects of growing iris, including all the varieties. I highly recommend this book!
