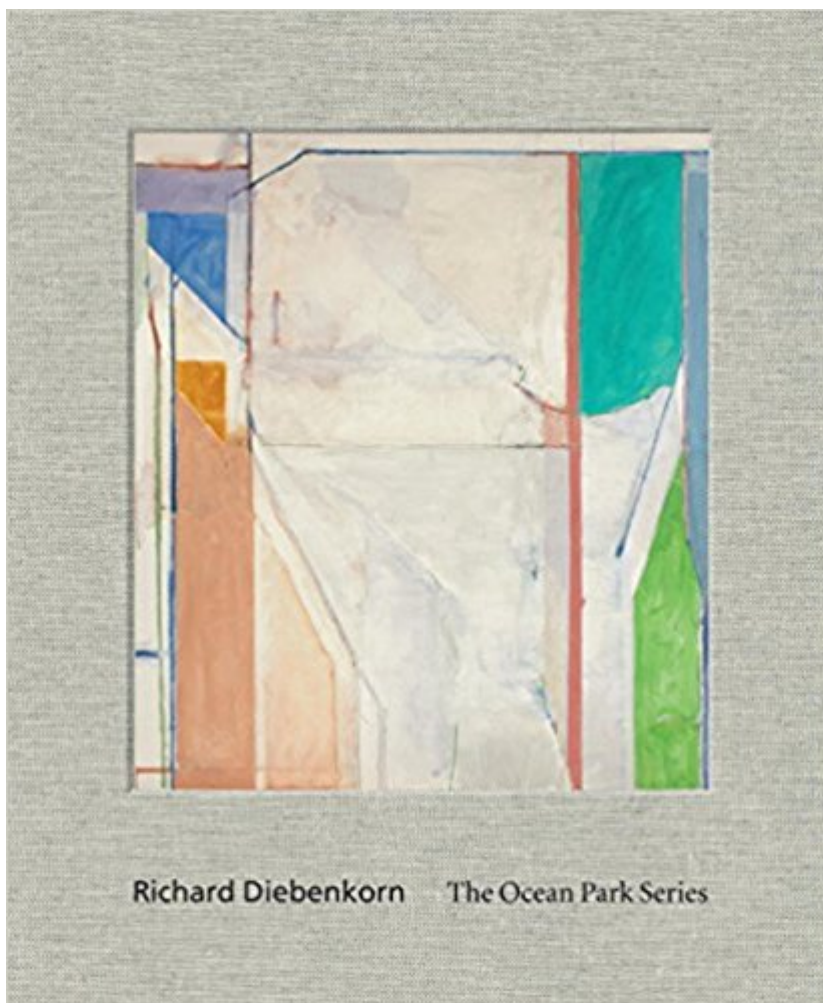

The result is a timely re-examination of a major body of work that will excite the numerous fans of this quintessential California artist.

This is a must get for those who love Diebenkorn's Ocean Park paintings. There is just the right amount of text in the beginning, followed by at least 139 fabulous color illustrations of these incredible paintings. The heavy weight paper is what you would expect for a quality art book. What is curious though, is why some painting were not properly enlarged to more adequately fit the page instead of being only postcard-sized. Also surprised that there was no dust jacket, but in all, a fantastic book on the Ocean Park series.

First off, I love looking at art especially paintings and prefer to see them in person but that can be difficult most of the times so seeing great reproductions are the next best thing. And I hate it when you get a book on an artist with a great sense of scale & color and the book's reproductions are small (and worse if they are in black & white). This is not the case with this book. Really excellent full page reproductions, well printed and in my estimation worthy of the amazing artwork Mr. Diebenkorn created. I would rate this book as an essential book to add to your art-book collection. And if you are a fan of Richard Diebenkorn, what you don't already have this? Then stop reading reviews and get it now. You won't be disappointed.

I just opened my new book, "Richard Diebenkorn: the Ocean Park Series" and was astonished to find what look like defective reproductions of some of the works. I compared several plates with the same paintings in "Richard Diebenkorn, Revised and Expanded" by Gerald Nordland and "The Art of Richard Diebenkorn" by Livingston, Elderfield, and Fine. While there are some differences between those 2 books, they are nothing like the bleached out reproductions of some of the same plates in the Ocean Park book. Ocean Park #130 is a good example of a very poor reproduction compared with the plates in Nordland and Livingston. For someone wanting most of the Ocean Park series, and high quality pictures, I think Gerald Nordland's "Richard Diebenkorn" is a better choice than this. This book suggests poor quality control. Very disappointing.

After seeing this book at the library, it was impossible not to buy a copy. The biographical section is interesting and each photograph draws you further into the collection. The images are beautiful, practically radiating their own light from the page and staying with you for a long time. A definitive
