

A. K. Turner's Vagabonding with Kids is a delightful and insightful how-to manual on getting the most out of exploring the world, no matter how old your kids are. The author artfully addresses such hurdles as limited budgets (try home exchanges); bringing the right attitude (think "gratitude"); and working remotely (sometimes the Internet is not your friend). Sit back and enjoy the ride as Turner, her pragmatic husband and two precocious daughters prove that you don't have to wait until "someday" to experience the adventure of a lifetime - you can plan it and go for it starting right now.
