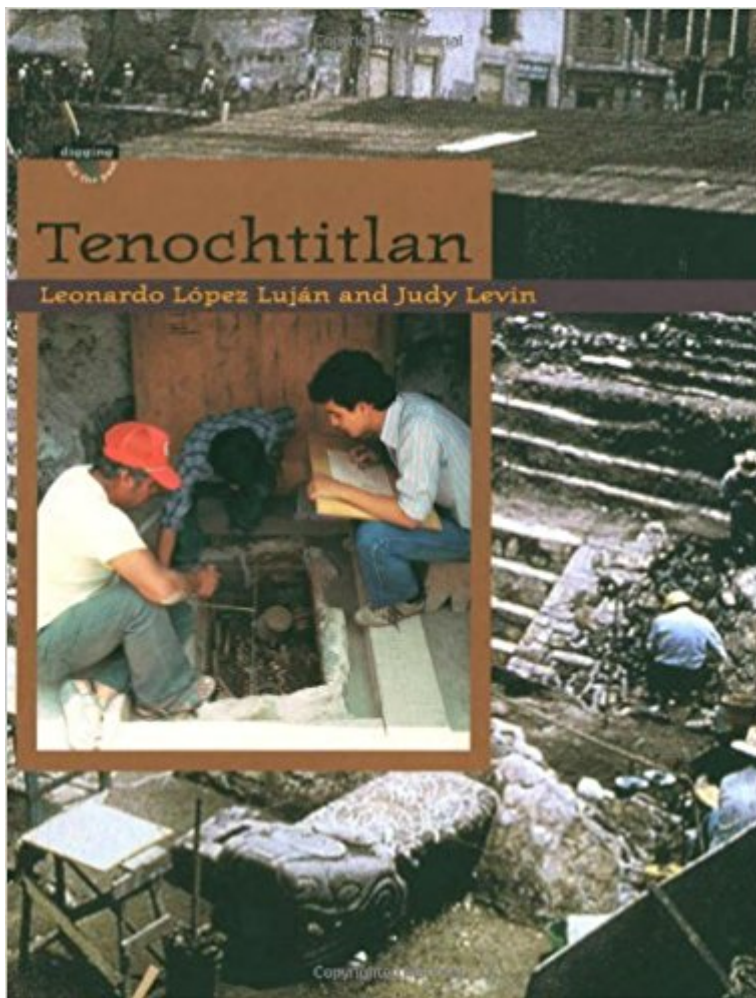

Although it is a bit short in length (40 some odd pages), this book is a good resource for those interested in Tenochtitlan, the Aztec Capital City. Written by the world's leading archaeologist specializing in sites of the Aztecs, it serves as a great source of both primary and (because it is one) secondary sources for research. The book is unique in that it focuses in on Tenochtitlan, rather than giving too much general information about the Aztecs (which is what I have found most books to do). While I'm not sure that this book would be worth paying upwards of \$15-20 for an individual, I was able to find a copy for a little over \$3 + \$4 for shipping. Great deal if you ask me. Especially considering the fact that the book has an excellent bibliography that can really help students and researchers make the most of their purchase (or rental if they're at a library). Check out the author's webpage, as he has many of his most important works available to read there (many of them are in Spanish, however).
