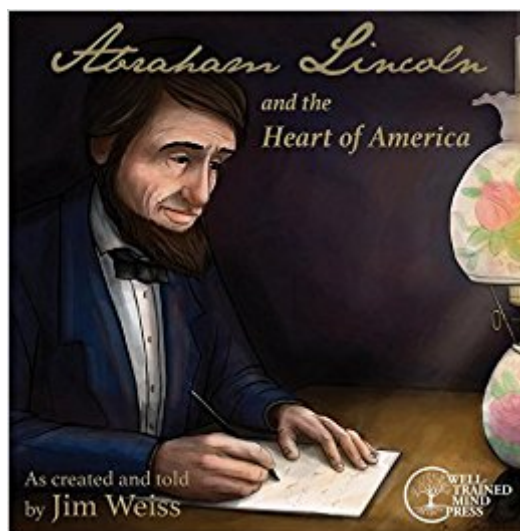

My 7 year old has been listening to this non-stop for the last few days. She and I have both learned a lot about the life of this great president and the circumstances surrounding the Civil War. And of course Jim Weiss always is a pleasure to listen to. Would be an excellent supplement to any elementary US History curriculum.

First let me say we have either bought or borrowed at least 6 or 7 of Jim's recordings. My 5 son has enjoyed his knights of the round table, robin hood and guliver's travel CDs for more than year. His pre-k teacher did an extended lesson Lincoln about presidents day and my son became very interested in Lincoln. As a result, I purchased this CD. However, unlike some his other recordings, I think one is for an older audience. I hope when he's older he will enjoy this as well.

My children, ages 7&9, love listening to this. We had read a lot about Abraham Lincoln already, but this added so much insight and we all enjoy Mr. Weiss' story telling.

My kids have loved this cd (ages 8 and 6). I put it in one night as they were going to sleep. And I never heard any complaints from them about it. All of Jim Weiss' cds that we have have been wonderful. I enjoy the way my children get to learn about history through this cd.

My kids ages 12, 7, 4 have yet to hear a Jim Weiss CD they didn't like. Most of this story goes right over my 4yo's head but she enjoys hearing any story that he tells and this one is no exception. This CD takes the meaningless, lifeless facts kids learn about in school and presents it in a way that the kids will remember and enjoy. Abraham Lincoln was a real person who was once a child just like them and that makes his life mean something. Parents will enjoy listening too. He's not just a funny man with a big beard and big hat anymore. Definitely recommend this CD and any of Jim Weiss's other CDs.
