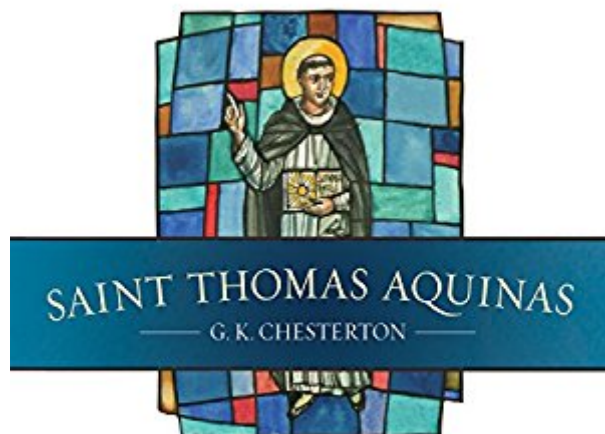

It is an interesting reflection on the life of Thomas Aquinas. The anti-asian comments by the author are somewhat disturbing.

Numerous people who should know have claimed that this is hands down the best biography of Thomas Aquinas that exists. There's good reason for that. The book is magnificently executed with typical Chestertonian flair for metaphor and paradox. In the hands of another writer this would cover up the figure being discussed, the Chesterton it illuminates. It is however, only a sketch of the great systematic philosopher, as Chesterton himself says at the beginning of the book. If you're looking for an introduction to Aquinas's philosophy I recommend Peter Kreeft's excellent books for laymen. (Kreeft is one of those who should know mentioned above). If you're looking for a personal introduction to Aquinas, you can't get better than this slim volume.

A very good book for people just starting to understand Saint Thomas Aquinas. It is the beginning of a wonderful journey.
