I am looking forward to where the characters go in the future. This was a great first book for a series, and IMO an exceptional first book for an author (even if MA helped). I would have really enjoyed reading more science, but let's face it, I am a geek.The violence in the book is pretty basic, (in terms of graphic), which is nice, and the "sexuality" is simply acknowledgement of certain physiological responses the human body has.About the book:Good references to the "universe" through out. This is far enough down the timeline that BA would start being seen as either a "boogeymen" or a myth, so I am glad that none of the "regulars" were shoe horned in.The "big fight" came a bit too early into the book (about 60%), but the remainder was the set up for the rest of the series. I am torn between feeling that this was well done and being upset that the climax happened so soon.I am also upset that this book is only the first in the series and I have to wait for the next. That's what I get for reading it the first week it was released.Also very happy to see some profanity that isn't "gottverdammt".I am curious to find out more about Molly in the future, and why the trust fund is so off limits.

Am I weird when I say I love the brilliant but broken characters? Molly is one. Joel, though, balances her well. As a team, they are unstoppable....of course, that teamwork does have some bumps and wrong turns...but that is all part of the growth pattern. There are enough hooks here to take us into the next set of books. Let's see where they take us with Molly, Joel, Sphinx, and the rest of their growing team.

I have finished reading this book and have to say that I am really looking forward to the next book. If you have not read other books in the Kurtherian Gambit Series I donâ ÂTMt think that you would have any issue with reading this book as while it is part of the overall universe it does not use any existing characters from previous books. The reason that I give this book a 5-star rating is the story was engaging and kept me wondering what was going to happen with the characters. I personally would like to see some more action but as the first book in a series I am willing to be somewhat flexible. I would be willing to challenge anyone to read this book and find it not enjoyable if you do then I am willing to read almost anything in the genre you would like to understand what you find enjoyable as I enjoy reading.
