

Itasca County provides a home for loons, wolves, bald eagles, bears, forests, porcupines, walleye, turtles, wild rice, deer, mountain lions, dragonflies, waterlilies, dear friends, 1007 lakes and Mary Shideler, who has kayaked every single one of those lakes. The journey, the Kayak Lady herself and this book are extraordinary. She has not condensed, she has given us succinct highlights - moments of wonder, fear, growth, joy, humor, and challenge in which to revel. The production values of this book are beautiful - gorgeous photographs, glossy pages that are a delight to turn, loads of white space. Shideler's writing is also beautiful. She reveals not only a portrait of the north woods, but a sense of herself as a complex, dogged, organized, focused mystic. Buy it for yourself if you're tired and discouraged or feeling cooped up. And get a couple of extras for friends. Get it for the people you love - for the one who needs to go after a dream, for the one who can respond to a challenge, for the one who has lived a life of wonder and who will respond to a kindred spirit - the Kayak Lady.
