

Not so different from many similar memoirs, but Ruth Silvestre still managed to draw me into their tale of renovating an old and neglected house, called Bel Air. Ruth and the characters of the village and farms are immensely likable, and although one simply knows how much hard toil is going to be involved for Ruth and her husband Mike one reads on with great glee and enjoyment. I've read all 3

of the "Sunflowers trilogy", one after the other. I loved the descriptions of the food of the region, maybe the detailed history of cathedrals and other historical places a little less so. (If one intends to wander that way, however, her meticulously researched historical details would be of great interest). I thoroughly enjoyed this book.

The author's love and appreciation for her French neighbors makes the story even better. If you liked this one, you might like Anne Loader's memoirs of buying a French farmhouse, too--her books were what made me continue to look for books like this one! Ms. Silvestre lovingly describes the land, the meals, and the way of life. You will want to head to their home for a visit!

I bought these Trilogy Series of "A House in the Sunflowers", as I love to read the category of "Travel" where writers let us, the readers, learn and enjoy other cultures, specially I do like reading about people who live away from the big melting pots, lost in the mountains and still connected as families and friends become a big family themselves. I didn't quite enjoy this first book. The writer gets lost onto too much noise of stories within the main story. I found myself "speedwritting" and not interested in what I call "the noise". Regardless, I am going to give it a second try by reading Book # 2.

It was well written. very good English, but too slow for me. It is all about restoring a house and French eating habits. There are a lot of comments in French, which are not translated all the time and I don't speak French.

The story line was interesting but difficult to follow with French interspersed in the sentences. My tablet doesn't have the capability to translate to English so some of the sense of story was lost.
