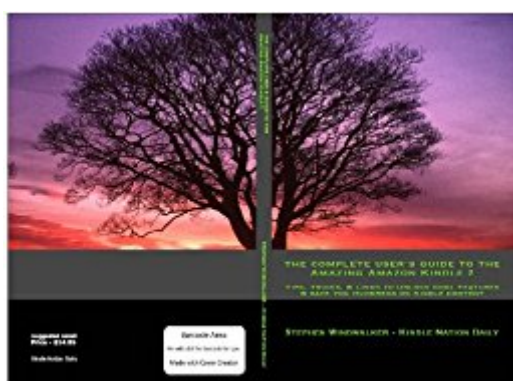

I received a Kindle 1 as a birthday gift back in November and followed the simple directions to download books and then read them. This worked. However, when I went to the website and read conversations with people that were doing more with the Kindle than I could understand, I purchased Windwalker's book. His ad offered information about "more" ways to use this revolutionary toy and I wanted more. His first book opened the door to understanding how this not just a reader, but a mini computer capable of bringing a huge world of books and information to my fingertips. Now my Kindle experience was great. By the time Kindle 2 came out, I was way hooked on this product, bought it and of course then immediately read his Kindle 2 information. Although I really enjoyed the struggle related to Kindle 1 (I have been working with computers since the early 80's) - his Kindle 2 book puts readers just a tiny click away from anywhere they want to go and any

books they want to read on this marvelous machine. Now the experience was terrific. Windwalker has made it easy to enjoy all the benefits of the Kindle 1 and 2. His advice and ideas are very valuable and the links are perfect. By the way, I'm a 73 year old woman and I find everything about this technology fantastic.

I have had this guide since I got my original Kindle2 in April 2009. It was my very first Kindle purchase, since I knew that I needed some good advice on how to get the most of my new purchase (and the manual was very weak). Frankly, I refer to it frequently for tips and suggestions on how to do various functions on my Kindle. I use it to help me download different material from the web onto my device. And, it showed me how to play some games like Gomoku (which I didn't even know were there). For you new Kindle owners out there, I really think this is the best guide for you. Mr. Windwalker has a great Kindle blog in which he continually demonstrates just how much he understands this terrific device and how to make it sing. That is all right here in this book. I read often on the forums questions on how to do various things on your Kindle. Don't bother- they are all right here. And, very easy to follow with step by step instructions. This is the guide to have. You'll end up keeping it on the first page of your home screen. That's how often it will help.

I downloaded this guide and read it from beginning to end. Although it is a good read to learn the intricacies of the Kindle, the document is in dire need of revision. It seems like each chapter was written independently from the rest and then put together. There is too much repetition (how many times does the author need to specify the cost of each Kindle model?, or that Whispernet 3G is free?, or the Kindle Customer Support number?, or...). In one chapter the author writes: "... 's just-launched but still unshipped Kindle 2...". The Index to Web-friendly Links section includes an extensive list of links that need to be updated and reorganized, and the duplicates should be removed. Removing redundancies would probably make the guide 20% smaller while giving it a more fluid transition between chapters. Other than that, it is a great primer for the Kindle user.

This is mostly regurgitated info from other sources. It also doesn't square very well with the title - the author has a lot of fluff about Kindle history, and other information that could hardly be called "Tips, Tricks & Links..." for the Kindle. It's hard to argue with a buck for this, but on the other hand, lots of your time will be spent wading through the excess. It's made me wary of what sort of other things will masquerade as content on the Kindle. Here's a feature I should have used - Sample.

This is a good guide, with some fairly obvious - if one had thought of them - hints about managing and sorting titles on your Kindle, and some useful browsing links for finding other books (especially free books) that aren't on . The main problem - and it is a problem with Kindle 2 itself - is that the Basic Web facility doesn't work at all in the UK (does it work anywhere outside the US?). So advice about websites, google, email and so on are beside the point. To get at those we have to rely on our computers after all. Admittedly we can then download to the Kindle via a USB link, but don't expect to get at the web while on the move with just your Kindle.

This book discusses the differences between the first and second versions of the Kindle reader. There are significant differences in the hardware configuration between version 2 and the present 3G version of the machine and the firmware (3.01 and above) which make the book less attractive to buyers of newer machines.

I am sorry that I had to give this book any star at all, just to get started on the review. I have been dying for it to appear in my books to be reviewed. In my 65 years of reading, involving thousands upon thousands of books - fiction and non-fiction - I have never come across a worse book. It does not do one thing which the title suggests it should. It is an exercise in self-aggrandisement on the part of the author, who keeps telling you what he's going to tell you but never does.

I had hoped for some help with actually using my Kindle but the content in this thing really did not help me use my Kindle. The guide that comes with the Kindle is pretty vague and leaves a lot out, and this book does not expand much on that. I got it for free so I don't feel cheated, but it really was not much help to me. In fact, to me it did not seem to be about actually using a Kindle much at all, as a tutorial on other things associated with Kindles such as self publishing.
