

It is finally time for Guts and his friends to face the trolls, and there are a whole bunch of them! This basically takes this whole volume, but even though it is concentrated on this fight, there is enough developments to keep things interesting. For example, we just barely got introduced to the trolls in the last volume, but already in this one we get more players in the party when an ogre joins in, not to mention another fantastic creature with some intriguing capabilities. In the middle of this, we see Farneze finally finding a new path in life, consisting in protecting Casca, and right away this is seriously tested. There are two things that I particularly enjoyed throughout this volume. The first one has to do with seeing Serpico finally unleashed and showing his full potential as a character and as a fighter. The other one has to do with the priest of the town attacked by the trolls, his difficulty accepting the help of a witch and the limitations that religion puts upon his thinking. This is a recurring theme with Miura and there are many portions of the story dealing with these topics and that could probably be interpreted in many different ways. I found this volume to be entertaining, though the plot does not evolve nearly as much as in some of the previous ones. But that's OK, it was time for a nice slug-fest.
