

" Well, there is nothing "demonstrated" in the book. There are no diagrams or pictures to "demonstrate" what is being discussed in the narratives. Additionally, there are no page numbers on the individual pages in the book, only on the table of contents page. This means that you have to flip through all the pages until you come to the subject you are interested in. Fortunately, this is a very small book so it does not take too long to find the subject you are interested in. I bought the book as a gift for my 10 year old Grandson who is able to snowboard at Big Bear CA only a few days every winter. I may eventually give it to him, however it is not "gift" quality.On the plus side and to find something nice to say about the book.
