

While there is sufficient material in this volume to surely please the experienced collector, the newer collector is sure to come away from this book far better equipped to derive countless hours of joy from this field.

Fountain Pens Past & Present is an excellent book for both the new and/or advanced collector of fountain pens. The history of each of the major Pen Companies is short but contains valuable information giving the reader a usable history of the pen from the very beginning until the present. The photographs are excellent and informative. In addition, the advise given on beginning and maintaining a collection, judging the condition and value of pens in the marketplace, and other meaningful information make this book a must if you fancy antique/vintage fountain pens. I give it five (5) stars.

As a coffee table book Fountain Pens Past and Present is great, or would be if the cover was more interesting. As a refference book, it's not altoghether bad. It has quality fotographs and moderately good descriptions, but does not cover that much or has so many examples (enought to know there is a lot to be covered, thought). As a price guide, forget it. Every price guide gets dated quickly, but this one seemed off the mark from the day I got it. Maybe pens traded at those prices where the author lives, but not elsewhere in the States, let alone abroad. If you are a beginner collector, gatherer, etc, it is as good as any other introductory book, but it certainly is not the definitive source. On the other hand, it is very well written and a pleasure to read and look at.
