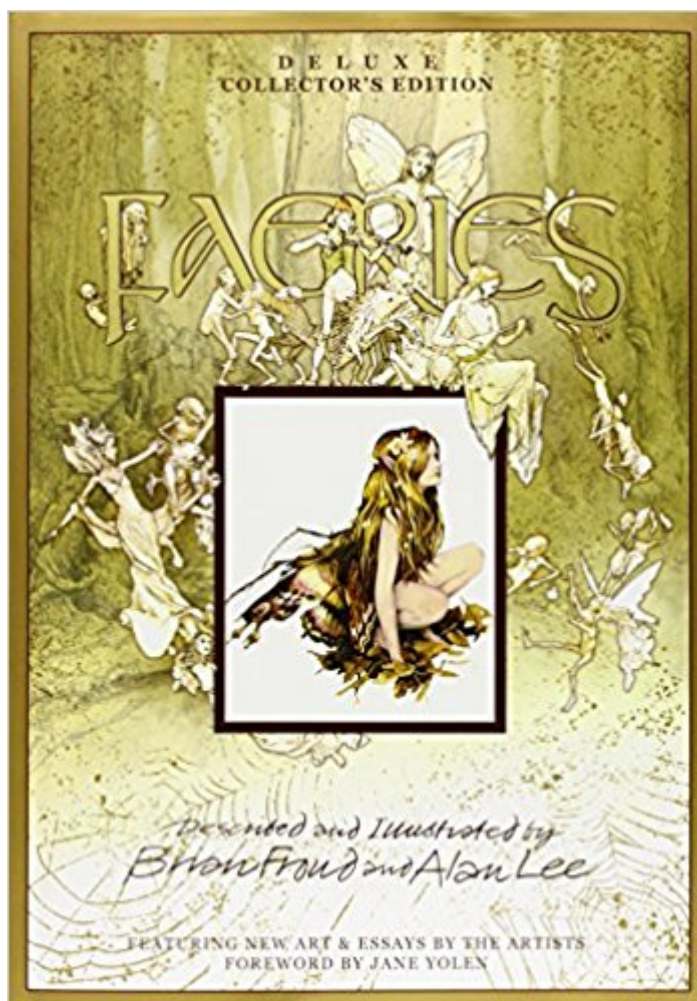

Twenty-five years ago, self-proclaimed "faery authorities" Froud and Lee published the first edition of their imaginative faery field guide. Since then, the two have gone on to publish numerous faery books and contribute their ideas to such fantasy films as *The Dark Crystal*, *Labyrinth*, *Legend* and the new *Lord of the Rings*. This expanded version, like its predecessor, features pencil drawings and watercolors of mythical creatures, as well as brief descriptions of their origins and powers; it draws on a long history of phantasmagoric iconography in the generally occidental vein. It boasts new art and introductions by the artists, as well; in its silver anniversary, the bewitching quality of its content remains. Besides faeries, the authors also include renderings of many other denizens of faery land-goblins, dwarves and leprechauns, for instance-as well as stranger breeds, such as the Fachan, a one-armed, one-legged oddity from the Scotland highlands and the Jack-in-Irons, a

This book is amazing! The art is truly fantastic, and even comes with a fold out poster of the cover, as well as a handful of framable prints that are really cool!

Anyone serious about learning from faeries has to check out this book. Its pages are full of knowledge and fascination. It is not a documental but rather a compilation of popular wisdom brought to life by two of the most important interpreters of faerie art and folklore. It will be fun and at the same time you will come out feeling you understand your world a little better. But faerie is a vast subject and you can search your entire life for the meaning of it and your place in it and never truly understand it all. So consider this just a stepping stone on your long journey.

Bought as a gift well received, we chose this book for our mom, who is in her sixties. she has a love of all things fairy and we thought, this was a beautifully represented story. I did not read the story myself, but flipped through the book. The illustrations are beautiful and the dust jacket makes it
