

I have several Life Change Bible reading guides and this is one of my favorites. Nice balance of thoughtful questions, word meanings, cultural aspects that clarify meaning of the passages. Mark is has more action than discourse and there isn't always an explanation in the text so this guide was especially helpful. In addition, the guide offers question for application and further study if you want

more depth.

This study guide on Mark is the second LifeChange Bible study the group I'm in has done. (The other was on Ezra and Nehemiah.) I've been impressed by both of these study guides. The one on Mark provides basic information on the nature of this Gospel and how it differs from the other Synoptics. After this introduction, the study guide consists of a series of lessons that consider passages from the book of Mark and ask questions on the passage under consideration, with space to write one's answers to these questions. Most of these questions are not superficial but make the student think seriously about the passage. In addition, each lesson contains notes for application, for thought and discussion, and for further study.Although I used the guide on Mark as part of a group Bible study, this study guide would also be useful for individual study. All in all, it provides an excellent introduction to the book of Mark.
