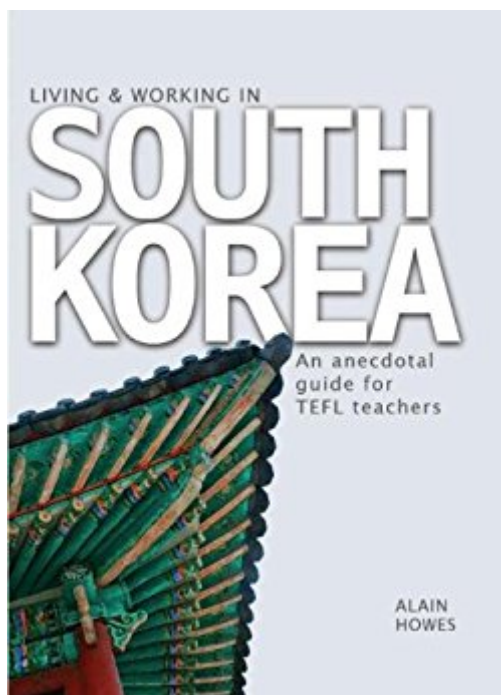

Very detailed about his own experiences, and things one will most likely experience while in Korea. The author is quite witty at times, and contains some quite humorous stories. This is a very informational read as well for those preparing to go abroad to South Korea. I recommend this great read for anyone traveling to Korea, and especially those going to teach in Korea. The author contains great advice on how to face culture shock, how to socialize as an expat in Korea, as well as advice on banking, language study, hospitals and more.

This book has tons of information about teaching English in South Korea. It is cleverly blended with sections on the culture, customs, food, arrival, anything that you might be curious about if you are at all considering teaching there for a year. The author spent two years there and puts in short stories from experience about the culture, customs, food, etc. These short stories are hilarious. Did you know that farting in public is quite common over there? They need to release some of that pent up cabbage, apparently. He shares what it's like showering at a gymnasium, the way Koreans dry themselves off; what it's like going grocery shopping or searching for a specific product; traveling with the students on a field trip. You'll learn about the apartments, toilets, transportation, what the school you work for expects. It really is a great read and I found it to be extremely informative.
