

It's a lovely book, nicely printed on heavy, glossy stock. The photographs are very nice. The book is basically aimed at the absolute beginner photographer, such as real estate agents, brokers etc. Those of you who are already seasoned photographers and are just looking for a book to give you some fresh ideas will find that the majority of this book will not apply to you.

There are a lot of good ideas in this book. Since I'm in real estate, I know the importance of good pictures. Ed Wolkis isn't going to give exact settings (a complaint in some of the reviews). If you want to learn about your camera, get another book. What he does is suggest solutions for many different kinds of situations. He also makes the important point of taking pictures that are interesting - not just one that shows a room with a lot of noise due to poor composition. I might add that he is available by email because he answered a couple of my questions which greatly increased the quality of my pictures. I recommend it.

I purchased this for a gift and followed up with the person to whom it was given. They are in an industry where they are taking a large number of photos of real property and as a result of starting this job, they needed to get up to speed rather quickly on real estate photography. When I asked for and received feedback, I was told that many of the questions that had been asked prior to receiving this book were answered upon the first reading. The book is easy to understand and full of examples and very plain guidance. This book would be excellent for real estate professionals, home decorators, home stagers or any other professional involved in selling or showing property.
