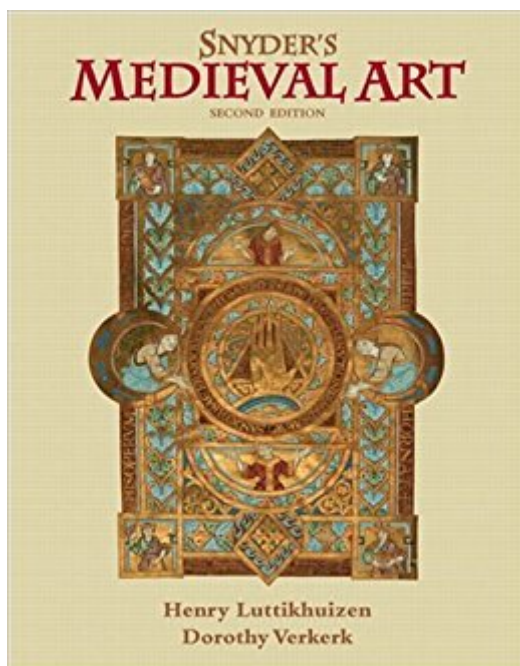

This book is extremely difficult to read or use as reference. The text dances around any actual points to fill space on the page. Would not recommend.

If you are into medieval art, art history or if it is your major, definitely get this book. Great facts and you can use it when you go visit these places if you ever do.

The book is very descriptive and has beautiful pictures of the artwork. It is a great value for rented text book.

This book is unnecessarily verbose. It takes them 3 paragraphs to describe something I could do in 2 sentences. Would not recommend.

Yes, I know it's cheaper than buying from the publisher directly, but the product should still be usable. I had to cut the pages apart with scissors - the folios were unseparated for about 70% of the book. That's a lot of tedium and papercuts!

As the parent purchasing books for my son, I feel that makers of text books really have students over a barrel. This is a paperback book and it costs over \$100. It will be used for one semester and the resell value will be less than 50%. I wish could offer a greater discount. As someone who loves physical books, (I've been in publishing most of my career life), I can unfortunately understand why soon no paper books will be available. Aside from the cost, the interactive features that will come as part of the package will make these physical books much less desirable. This semester, all three of my son's paperback textbooks cost over \$100/each.
