

Victoria Simcox has done a marvelous job in this first entry in the Bernovem Chronicles series. The groundwork for the saga is laid. Things aren't going very well at school for twelve-year-old Kristina. She is being bullied relentlessly. If only something or someone could whisk her away from it all. Of course, that is precisely what happens in this magical tale. Kristina becomes the recipient of the Warble, a magical item that takes her away to a wondrous land of fairies and dwarfs, a place where her pet rat, along with every other animal in Bernovem, has the ability to speak. However, Kristina isn't just carried to this land by the Warble. She becomes its caretaker. It becomes her responsibility to ensure that Bernovem is freed from the clutches of the evil Queen Sentiz. In order to free Bernovem, she must return the Warble to its final resting place. Helping her along the way are the sibling fairies Clover and Looper and Werrien, the rightful prince of Bernovem. This story is an absolute treasure! It is the classic hero's journey told by a masterful writer. Kristina is taken from victim in a world that readers will be familiar with to hero in a world that is stunningly and vividly brought to life through the imaginative writing of Victoria Simcox. It is a fantastic transformation, one that readers will not want to miss!

Although this is not typically my kind of genre, I stepped outside my box to experience something new. And, am I glad I did. The Warble is a pleasant surprise in that it's not just a tale of fantasy. It holds truth and real life principles that are steadfast in our real lives. The main character, Kristina, holds the pain of rejection from society or her peers. Through her suffering, one person sees her potential and offers her a gift in the Warble - an unsuspecting metal ball that is the key to her destiny through another world - one where Kristina is labeled 'The Chosen One'. There are threads that point to God and his everlasting love in this book. The story parallels Jesus' return and his victory over a fallen world. Those that have the faith - will see it. Those that don't want religion thrown in their face don't have to worry because it's so slight all you'll uncover is a really good book that offers a story of good triumphing over evil. Great job Ms. Simcox! I enjoyed this book and how it spoke to me on many different levels.

This is a delightful book that I would recommend for the younger set. It reminded me very much of the classic Chronicles of Narnia by C.S. Lewis.Maybe a bit like Alice in Wonderland, too, yet with a unique flavor of its own.The tale centers around 12-year-old girl named Kristina, who is transported to a magical land by the power of the Warble, a mysterious jewel. Accompanied by her pet rat, Raymond, she meets a world of interesting creatures, to include talking animals. There is Remalock,

a dwarf, Prince Werrien and faries named Clover and Looper, to name a few. There are also evil beings to include a wicked queen. It's a good book for kids. Reading it as a childless adult, I was reminded that I would have liked it a lot more had I ran across this book when I was about nine.
