I love Janet Evanovich. I read a lot of her books. This series is no surprise with its quirkiness. She has a great thing going with these books. I am enjoying them immensely. Ok So a lost island How do you lose an island? Well you will be surprised in this book. It can happen. So Riley and Emmerson are off on another of his wild adventures. I must say that I am really digging the quirky eccentric man. Some of the things he does, you like wow! No he didn't. In this book the chemistry between Emerson and Riley starts to simmer. Not really heat up per say, since they are really slow at the whole idea of a relationship thing. Maybe it is because Emmerson is well how should I put this. He's well He's Emmerson. What can I say? I mean he is an extremely eccentric billionaire. His mind is moving a mile a minute. Not to mention that Riley sees Vernon naked more than any one. Awkward!!!! The banter between Riley and Emerson is cute and funny. The things Vernon says cracks me up. He is a nut job. Emmerson may be an eccentric billionaire with a big brain, but he is Riley's hero and I feel that these two will develop stronger feelings as the stories go on. I don't exactly think that Emmerson knows what to do with the feelings or how to express them, but it is funny watching him try. If you are looking for a little danger mixed with comedy, then this is the book for you. So pick it up today.

I've read almost all the fiction Janet Evanovich has written, and love most of it. I lived in Trenton while I first started reading the Stephanie Plum series. So naturally, I started this newer series. The first Knight and Moon story was very good. The characters are a riff on other Evanovich characters. (Think of all that Plum, O'Hare, and Moon have in common!) But this second book in the Knight-Moon series was a disappointment. Yes, it was fun. But it was quite far-fetched and unbelievable! The characters get out of scrapes that no one else could possibly escape. They are fun, but totally unreal.

A Buddhist Monk has lost his island, yes you read that right. Knight and Moon are going to help him find it. I really liked the first book in the series but this was definitely not my favorite. It stretched credibility a bit too far. There were all sorts of crazy characters but I didn't find it nearly as funny as the first. I also found myself skimming parts of the book. It seemed to jump around a lot and was a bit confusing, maybe because I skimmed? I hope the next book is better.

Emerson and Riley are on another adventure. This time Emerson's cousin, Vernon, and friend, Wayan Bagus are along for the ride. Wayan Bagus contacts Emerson because he was drugged and kidnapped from his island and when he recovered, the island was gone! Of course, this was a problem that intrigued Emerson. There were moments of humor and fear in this story and even a little romance. I enjoyed the story.

I love love loved it. I am sure there will be more because we need more of Vernon and Alani and we need to find out since he has no island to go back to what will happen to the monk and will they finally get to see each other naked.

This is a fun read. Not really in the possibility of really happening, but something to think about. This book kept my attention and I wanted to discover how it ended. I would recommend this to all Evanovich readers.
