All the photos were beautiful--- glossy pages would have really made this book AMAZING-- but I understand regular paper pages probably made this book MUCH more affordable for us buyers as it is a very THICK book. This book covers so much! A lot of the info can be found on the blog, but it's so much nicer to just be able to thumb through to the right spot in a book---though not all the information on the website is there or as extensively there--- at least on some flowers. I wish they would include information on zones for flowers (instead of general--- "in places where winter is very cold" etc..), but that's how the info is presented on the blog too. Anyways! I'm a tough critic in general & a researcher... more info could have been there sure but at 307 pages this is already a wonderful, extensive & textbook like resource! Amazing buy.

This book really is full of valuable information, whether you are a home gardener or considering a flower business. I love that it is arranged by season. And, the tips she provides on growing each

flower type would takes years to learn on your own by trial and error. Her arrangements are stunning, and the instructions provided on how to create them are simple to follow. I really enjoyed reading this book and will use it as a reference for years to come!
