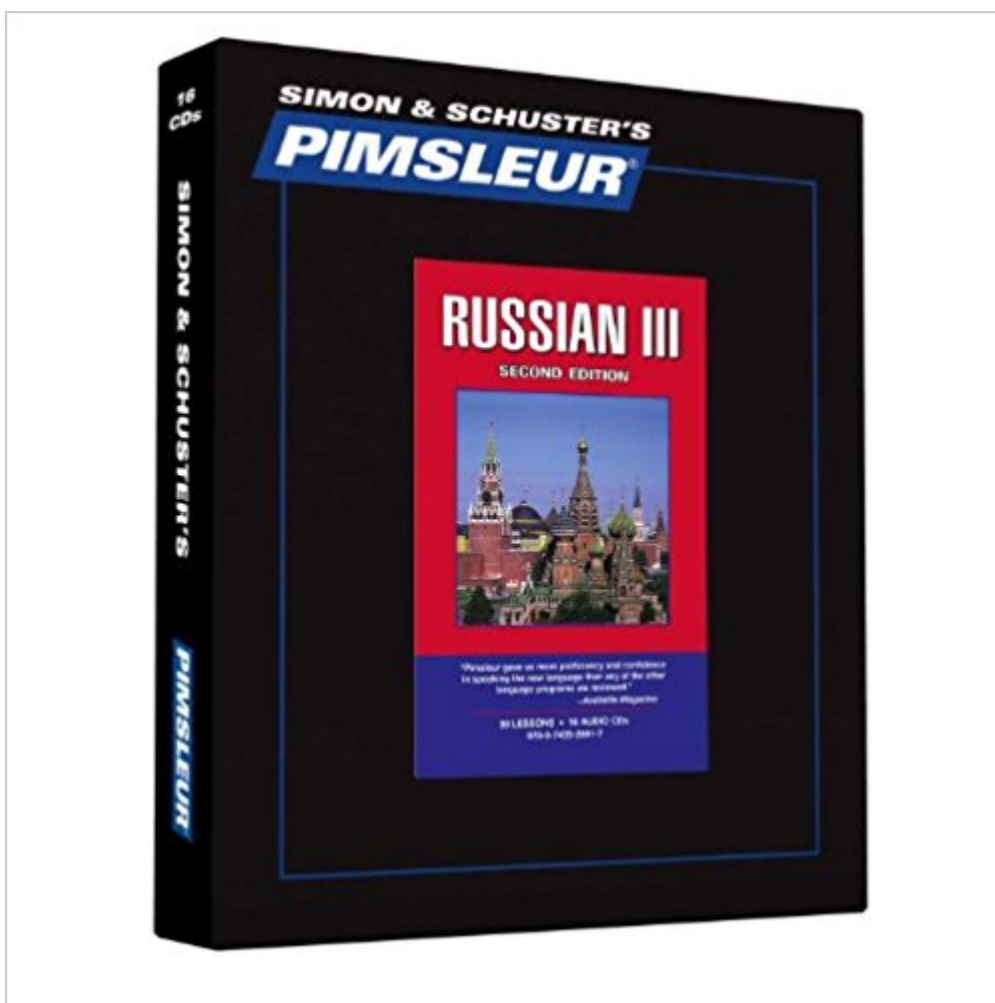

Dr. Paul Pimsleur devoted his life to language teaching and testing and was one of the world's leading experts in applied linguistics. After years of experience and research, Dr. Pimsleur developed The Pimsleur Method based on two key principles: the Principle of Anticipation and a scientific principle of memory training that he called "Graduated Interval Recall." This Method has been applied to the many levels and languages of the Pimsleur Programs.

Great, Great simply Great. I have already done Russian I and II, and managed to impress my in-laws already. The way I am doing and it's the same way I have done the first two, is, I will not switch to the next lesson until I master the current one, which in all honesty, doesn't take more than 3 or 4 go-arounds, and you will be able to at least maintain a five-minute small talk conversation with a Russian speaker person. I am currently on lesson 4, and already feel I have learned so much more. The system is very clever, and keeps you fresh and focused throughout.

This type of learning fits my lifestyle with the 30-minute audio segments. I can easily get in some language learning on a car ride or out walking the dog, and the manufacturer is correct that repetition helps learning. I'd encourage people to also find some written learning material to supplement this as well. I recently started formal classes, but my use of the Pimsleur I and II had me well ahead of most of my classmates.

Not the most advanced language skills, but it helps me keep my Russian skill up to date. It would be better if all the lessons had a written version to refer to, as sometimes it is difficult to distinguish some sounds for others.
