

This work is a bit "dated" due to the style of writing and speaking they had at the time, but none-the-less I think most of these lessons would be clear enough for most readers. Although the writing style might be a bit dated, the concepts and lessons within it are as important as ever! Beautiful little book and an interesting read. The print is first class. A fine introduction to Washington's personal code of conduct. Most of the rules are common sense and apply to contemporary etiquette, while others are quite dated. The style in this version could have been more appealing, for example by working a little more with the language. The old style can be preserved while at the same time avoiding unnecessarily complicated sentences. A good read, after all.

While helping my young niece with a homework project on George Washington, I mentioned that I owned this book. I had purchased it years ago at a gift shop while on vacation. I fished it out and showed it to her and she liked it so I decided to get a copy for her birthday. I looked it up and bookmarked it but it when it came time to purchase it I began reading reviews about all the left-wing diatribes that had been added as commentary. I avoided that version (which looks identical on the cover) and sought out this one. I can attest that it is the same as the version I purchased years ago, with a nice introduction but otherwise free from any extraneous political commentary.
