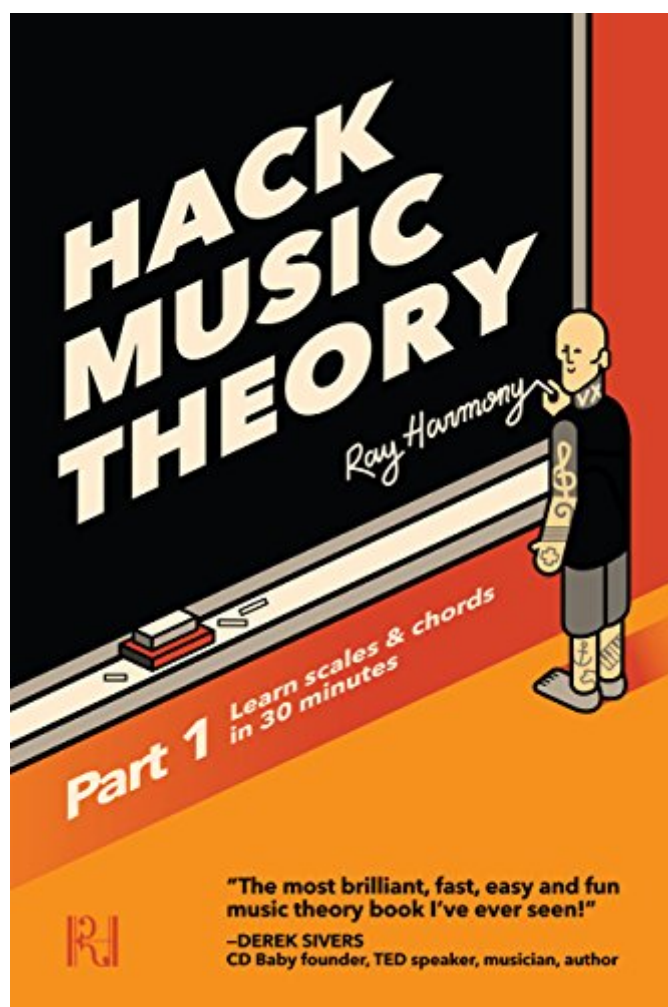

This was a great read. Of course, all of the information is accurate and spot on, but what I liked most was how everything was presented. The pages contain enough humour and wit to remind you that music is supposed to be fun, and indeed Ray even comes out and flatly reminds of that on several occasions. The book is filled with very well done diagrams and visually represent complex ideas, and despite already having a music background, I find that many of the diagrams gave me a new way to look at certain concepts. Another aspect that I found great was the mix of just enough history with regard to why we have the system we have today. Something I have discovered over the years is that I learn very well when facts are accompanied by an explanation, and I'm sure others benefit from the same thing. If only grade school mathematics classes had been taught this way.

Ray Harmony has really done something special with this book. Concise, easy to read and he absolutely breaks down music theory into tasty little bites. The best book on chords and scales I have ever read. Coupled with Ray's video series, I feel very confident that Ray is absolutely the real deal, and that by following this series I will actually have the ability to learn and absorb the fundamentals of theory.
